DISCUSSION: RECOMMENDATION FOR DESIGNATING ORANGE AVE ONE-WAY STREET NORTH FROM WASHINGTON STREET TO MARY AVENUE.

May 24, 2022

Background:

As part of the Washington Street reconstruction, and due to safety issues, one of the options to address the safety concerns is to designate Orange Ave north from Washington Street to Mary Ave as One-Way. We feel that this needs to be implemented now since # of crashes is increasing due to visibility at the intersection specially for traffic traveling south on Orange and trying to head east on Washington or continue south on Orange. Staff have approached businesses in the area few months ago and received positive feed back. We will approach them again before this is implemented. Attached please find the number of crashes since 2019. This year until first week of May, we have 7 crashes.

Staff is recommending the designation of Orange Ave north from Washington Street to Mary Ave one way effective immediately.
