Purpose: The City of Saint Paul is proposing to use a property in the West 7th Street neighborhood as a day “shelter” to provide services to individuals experiencing homelessness. The project would create additional indoor space that would allow unsheltered individuals to escape weather conditions, access bathrooms, and to connect one-on-one with essential social services on site, operating from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Background: The number of unsheltered individuals in Saint Paul has risen substantially to 300 living in tents, under bridges, and in caves throughout the City. The COVID-19 pandemic has exacerbated the plight of the City’s unsheltered homeless and highlighted the need to strengthen the system that supports and transitions those who are unsheltered toward permanent housing. There is an urgent need to expand the City’s limited space for homeless individuals to access services in diverse locations throughout the City.
