Motivating System

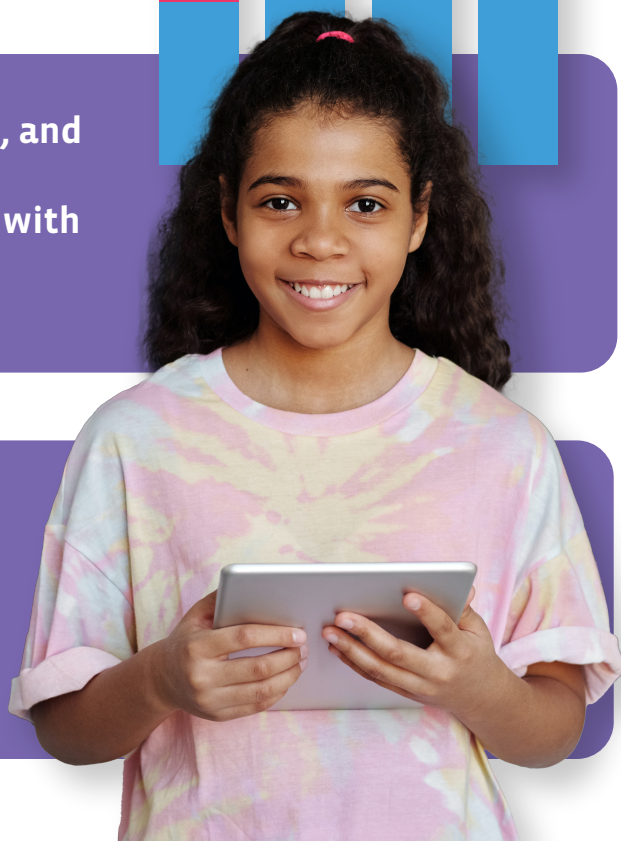
The game-like scoring system makes kids want to keep working hard to improve their scores. Progress graphs provide immediate positive feedback and drive continued motivation.



What is the Summer Slide?

The Summer Slide is a decline in reading ability that can occur over the summer months between school years.

How does it work?

One Minute Reader includes 8 books in each level (early first-grade through mid-fifth grade). There are five nonfiction stories in each book.

1

Select a Story

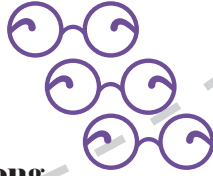
The reader logs into One Minute Reader and selects a book and story.



3

Read Along

The reader reads aloud along with a recording of the story to learn the words and build comprehension. The reader can click on challenging words for kid-friendly vocabulary definitions.



4

Read Alone

The reader builds fluency by reading the story independently in timed increments. After this step, the reader can see how their words-correct-per-minute score improved from the cold reading.



2

Cold Readings

The reader clicks the Start button and reads for one minute. The reader can click on unknown words to hear them pronounced. A graph shows the reader's words-correct-per-minute score after the minute is over.



5

Quiz, Joke Jumble, and Crossword

The reader answers questions about the story. The correct answers will solve the book's joke jumble. A crossword at the end of each book reinforces newly learned vocabulary words.



What's included?

One Minute Reader includes content at six reading levels (E-5) ranging from beginning reader through fifth grade. A simple placement process helps determine the right level for each reader.

E

Early first-grade reading level: Stories consist of a few short, simple sentences with several words repeated.

1

Middle first-grade reading level: Stories consist of a few short, simple sentences with very few difficult words.

2

Middle second-grade reading level: Stories consist of simple sentences with a few difficult words.

3

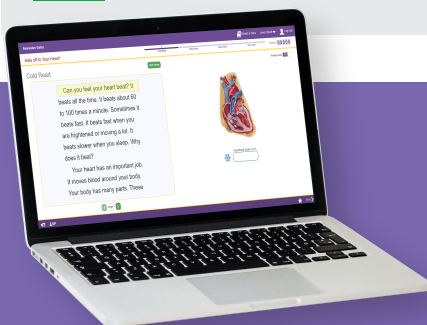
Middle third-grade reading level: Stories consist of longer sentences with several difficult words.

4

Middle fourth-grade reading level: Stories consist of some complex sentences with more difficult words.

5

Middle fifth-grade reading level: Stories consist of complex text with more advanced concepts.
