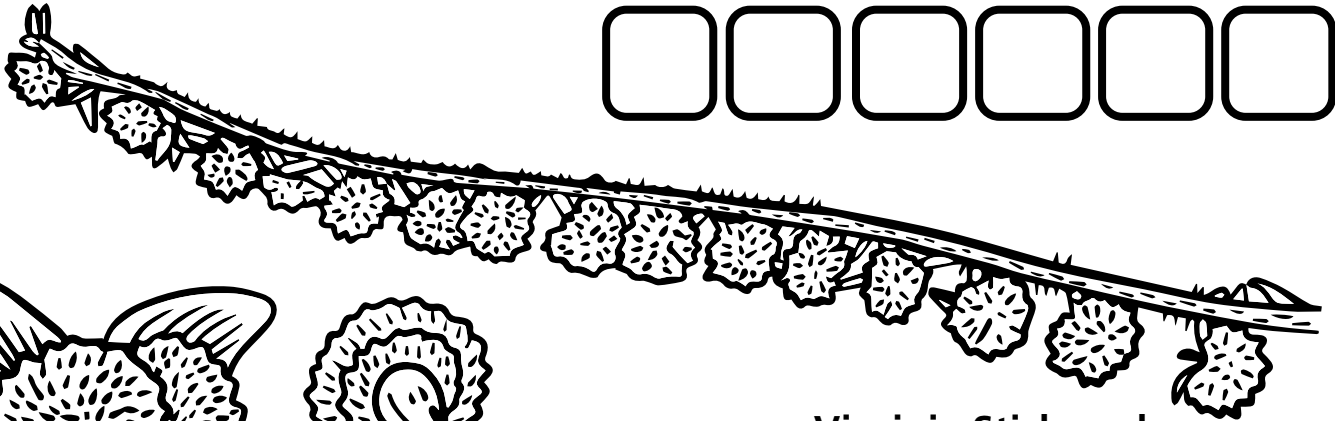
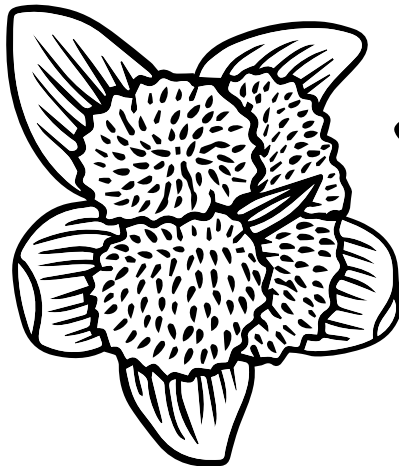


# Seeds that Stick

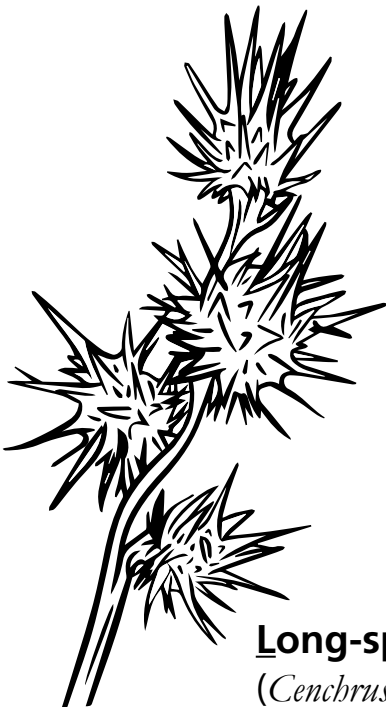


Virginia Stickseed  
(*Hackelia virginiana*)

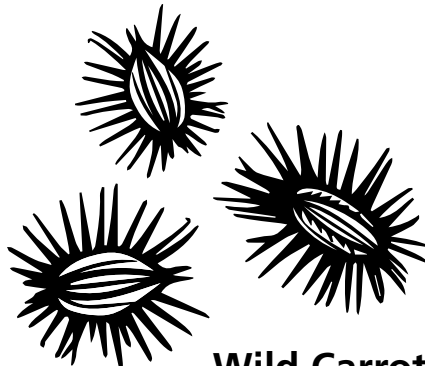

(*Cynoglossum officinale*)

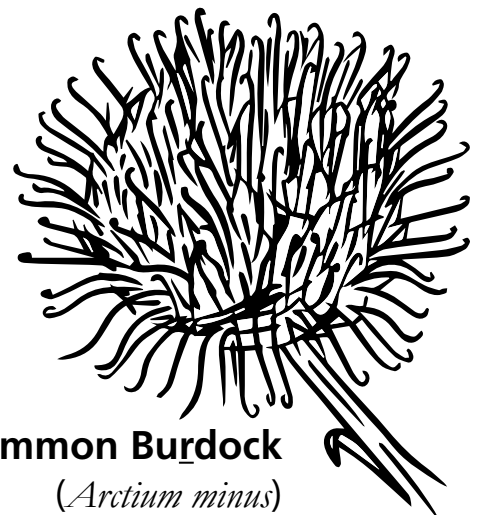
Devil's Beggarticks
