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DAY 2

YOU'RE A PERSON, NOT A PERSONA!

God was walking in the cool of the garden looking for Adam and Eve when they began to hide. God called out for them, and Adam spoke up, telling God that when they heard God's voice they hid because they were naked. God responded in Genesis 3:11, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?"

Let's dissect the character of God in this instance. He didn't berate the man or the woman, nor did He shame them. God gave them space to present the truth as they knew it.

God knew in that moment that the man and the woman were bearing fruit, but it wasn't the type of fruit God intended for them. When you know how good and holy and loving God is, you have no need to hide your raw, naked vulnerability from Him. We only begin to hide when we no longer trust who He is.

Don't fall into the trap of only presenting your good parts to God. You're a person, not a persona. It's much easier to present a persona to God than to present a person, but God doesn't want who you pretend to be.

DAY 3 LET'S BE FRUITFUL AND MULTIPLY

When God was in the garden He blessed creation, then told the first couple to be fruit-

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ful and multiply, but I don't think He was just talking about having sex and making babies. God was preparing humanity to live in a perpetual state of production where we are to take what God has given us, plant it, and allow it to produce over and over again.

When the serpent invaded Eve's realm and convinced her to eat from the tree, that snake was manipulating God's formula to fit his agenda. The serpent had a plan for the woman to be fruitful and multiply, but this time the fruit wouldn't make the world better. This time the fruit would separate humanity from God's vision.

The moment the woman ate from the tree, the serpent's idea was fruitful. But the moment God cursed the serpent in Genesis 3:15, that bad fruit was in jeopardy of no longer being able to multiply.

Let me quickly break this down for you: It doesn't matter what seed has been fruitful in your life. Your family may have been producing the type of fruit that has caused dysfunction for generations, but it is never too late to root out the bad seeds and plant God's seeds in their place.
