





The Octagon Star creates the illusion that the center is floating in an octagon. This effect is created by splitting rectangles and half square triangles. The Wing Clipper and Large Square Squared tools are used to make this fun block!

### Cutting Instructions: Per Block


| Units Name and # of Units                       | 9"                                       | 12"                                      | 18"                                      |

| <b>A: Split Rects Type 1 &amp; 2</b><br>4 Units | 1 ½" x 3" Finished<br>2" x 3 ½" cut size | 2" x 4" Finished<br>2 ½" x 4 ½" cut size | 3" x 6" Finished<br>3 ½" x 6 ½" cut size |
| <b>B: Flying Geese</b><br>4 Units               | 1 ½" x 3" Finished<br>2" x 3 ½" cut size | 2" x 4" Finished<br>2 ½" x 4 ½" cut size | 3" x 6" Finished<br>3 ½" x 6 ½" cut size |
| <b>C: Stacked Squares</b><br>4 Units            | 3" Finished<br>3 ½" cut size             | 4" Finished<br>4 ½" cut size             | 6" Finished<br>6 ½" cut size             |
| <b>C: Half Square Triangles</b><br>8 Units      | 1 ½" Finished<br>2" cut sized            | 2" Finished<br>2 ½" cut sized            | 3" Finished<br>3 ½" cut sized            |



## Block Assembly

1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press as desired.
3. Stitch the rows together, press as desired.

**Make (1) Block.**




