
Update on \$80K challenge in April

Cub Scout Packs are just getting back to a more comfortable place of meeting inperson, slowly increasing group sizes outside as the daylight hours grow longer. In May, June and throughout the summer, take advantage of the weather and ability to get together and have some FUN that your Scouts (AND families) really need!

Benefits of the Cub Scout Pack Challenge

- •Volunteer Prospecting: Get to know Pack families (especially parents who are potential volunteers) in an informal relaxed environment
- •Recruiting Opportunity: Scouts can invite a friend to participate
- •Retention: Families see communications and events on their calendar that keep Cub Scouting on their mind and calendar forming a bridge from spring to fall
- •Advancements: Many awards have outdoor components that are more difficult to accomplish in winter months, but could be nearly effortlessly added to a summer activity

- •Fall Fundraising can kick-off with returning Scouts earlier than beginning of the school year—before parents are burned out from other fundraisers, or scouts are taking hiatus for fall sports
- •Fellowship: Scouts get a chance to socialize with other Scouts in/outside of their dens, when it's not disruptive to formal pack meeting programs
- •**FUN**: Swimming, hiking, picnics, ice cream socials, S'mores nights-they are all FUN for Scouts and their families!
