TODAY'S FOCUS

Today is *Valentine's Day*, a hearts day. Today is *Ash Wednesday*, an ashes day. This is the start of the church season of Lent. How fitting that Ash Wednesday falls on this day. Over these next few weeks before Easter we see God's passionate love in giving His Son Jesus Christ. We see the ashes of our sin and guilt washed away from us as adopted children of God. We hear compassionate words of the living Savior Jesus. He sought, found, gathered, rescued us. Every day God fully and freely forgives us for His sake.

To Prepare Our Hearts for Worship

When you've found a place to sit, take a few minutes before the start of worship to quietly meditate and prepare to worship. A prayer like this may help focus your mind: *Heavenly Father, I'm here to worship You. You gathered Your flock to hear You and to encourage our hearts. Please give us hearts a ready and eager to hear and follow Your Word.*

When I see the ashes of my guilty sin, keep me thankful that You washed me clean. Restore my heart so that I respond with hearty praise and thanks. Amen.

Dear friends gathered by our Father,


At Good Shepherd we still follow the Scripture's teaching and tested practice of close communion. We believe God gathers His believers together and publicly unites us in the same Christian faith.
