Testled in the heart of Garrett County on the west bank of the Youghiogheny River is a real gem for locals and tourists alike. From the frozen falls overflowing with ice cicles in our seemingly eternal winters to the roaring falls and rock strewn swimming spots during the summer months, Swallow Falls State Park is a



must see destination in Garrett County. The entrance fee for the park is \$3 for Maryland residents, \$5 for out-of-state visitors, and children in a car seat are free. The park is open from 8 AM until dark. If you would like to plug the address of this natural wonder into your phone to guide you, the actual street address of the park is 2470 Maple Glade Road, Oakland MD 21550

Unfortunately, pets are not permitted in the day use area or on the Canyon Trail between the Saturday before Memorial Day and Labor Day. However after Labor Day to the Friday before Memorial Day weekend you can bring your furry friends along for the hike. Pets are allowed in the campground and on trails that connect with the state forest and must remain on a leash and

There are some Hemlock trees within the park that are older than when Ben Frank-



lin and Thomas Jeffereson were running around the East Coast. It's awe inspiring, but that scale of time really puts it in perspective. These trees pre-date the United States itself. One noticeable thing about the forest is that trees are allowed to rot and fall all over the park without being cleaned up. I spoke to a seasonal park employee named Tiara who explained that in order to protect the 300-year-old hemlock trees and their ecosystem, Swallow Falls is designated a Sensitive Management Area, which means trees are allowed to fall or burn as nature intended; only trees blocking trail access are cleared.

These trails offer a variety of dif-

ferent paths through the 257-acre State Park but the most popular hike is down to the waterfalls. Once you start down the trail, you can hear the roaring water! The trail continues for about 1.25 miles and has various terrain including level pathways, stairs, and some rocks. There are three waterfalls located along the trail, each varying in size. The biggest, Muddy Creek Falls, is a whooping 53-foot-drop and one of the highest natural waterfalls on the east coast. Continuing on Canyon Loop Trail from Muddy Creek Falls, through to Swallow Trails, and to Swallow Falls you can continue strolling casually along the Youghiogheny River. If it's your first time at the falls and you are with family, you should know that the hike is no more than an hour long.



If you hike or swim one thing is for certain - Biodiversity is on full display at Swallow Falls. According to allaboutbirds.org, Cliff Swallows are the namesake of the Park. "Often swarm around bridges and overpasses and in summer, offering passers-by a chance to admire avian architecture and family life at once. Clusters of their intricate mud nests cling to vertical walls...and (the Swallows) are nearly always found in large groups,

whether they're chasing insects high above the ground, preening on perches, or dipping into a river for a bath." It's not hard to see why the falls would be named after





these Swallows that used to nest in the upper part of Swallow Falls among the rocks.

Speaking of wildlife, there has been a noticeable uptick in the mentions of Black Bears on social media recently. So, seeing one on your trip to Swallow Falls is not the craziest idea. If you do happen upon one, be sure to remember not to panic. According to the Department of Natural Resources "Living with Black Bears" page, "They will associate people with food and may become a persistent problem for you and your neighbors. It is illegal to feed bears in Maryland. If you encounter a bear, remain calm. DON'T PANIC. Leave the area."

If you enjoy your visit to Swallow Falls, why not stay for awhile? There are sixty-five campsites with a fire ring, picnic table, and lantern post located near modern bath houses with hot and cold water. There are actually three sites that are full electric, water and sewer if you're not in the mood to "rough-it." There are even three camper cabins which include electric heat, microwave, small folding table and chairs, mini fridge, one double bed, and a bunk bed. Reservations are required for all three camper cabins from the first weekend in April until the first weekend in December. According to the website for the park, camping reservations are strongly recommended Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day by calling 1-888-432-2267 or online at parkreservations. maryland.gov.

This month's unsung hero focuses on a difficult and uncomfortable yet inevitable reality. The Hospice of Garrett County employees, and all they do to provide care for those of us on the way out of this life, are our Unsung Heroes for July 2022.

The concept of providing specialized care for dying patients began in England when a physician named Dame Cicely Saunders created the first modern hospice there in 1967. Four years prior, in 1963, Saunders introduced the idea to the United States

in a lecture at Yale University. Following this introductory lecture, the concept began taking root within the U.S. healthcare system when physician Dr. Elisabeth Kubler-Ross interviewed 500 dying patients for a book she published in 1969 called "On Death and Dying." In the bestselling book, she made a plea for home care as opposed to treatment in an institutional setting. She argued that patients should have the ability to participate in that decision-making. The result was what we know as Hospice today.

Hospice care is a specific type of healthcare regulated by Medicare for patients who have six months or less to live. However, services don't automatically end after six months. Some people in hospice care live much

longer, and the service is not just for elderly patients. Children receive hospice care, as do patients with any end-stage chronic illness, as well as those with progressive degenerative diseases like Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease, ALS, and more. Hospice's goal is to make the patient as comfortable as possible.

Locally, Hospice of Garrett County provides in-home nursing care, certified nursing assistants, social workers, volunteer caregivers, dietary counseling, medical supplies, equipment, medications, and short-term, or respite care, as needed, at no cost to the patient or family.

The following is a brief interview with Donna Jo Brenneman, the Executive Director of Hospice Garrett County LLC, in the post since 2014.

What is the number one takeaway from your personal experience with Hospice?

Sometimes medical facilities wait too long to refer a terminally ill patient to our services. We hear time after time: Why did we wait so long to get your services!

What do you and the other Hospice employees do in Garrett County and beyond? Once a patient gets the diagnosis of 6 months or less to live, we are able to go in and provide our services and supplies at NO cost to the patient or family, regardless of insurance status. This includes medicines, wound care supplies, and products like Ensure, Depends, etc.

What are some of the biggest issues Hospice faces?

Staffing is always an issue because we never know how many patients we will be serving at any given time. We serve the entire County and have to have Nurses and CNAs to provide adequate service at all times.



Who are the other people managing the day-to-day of the organization? What do they do?

We have Dr. Dan Miller as our Medical Director; Grace Bolyard, Clinical Director; Amy Welch, Financial Administrator; Ashley Colmer as our Volunteer Director and HR, Andrea Davis as the Office Manager and Bereavement Director. And, of course, all of our nurses and aides who work tirelessly to help our patients.

Can anyone volunteer? How do you volunteer?

Volunteers are always welcome! We have administrative volunteers that assist with mailings etc., and then we have Patient Care Volunteers that go out in the homes to sit with patients, read, play music, etc. to give caregivers some respite and provide additional resources for the patients. What further info do you wish the public knew about Hospice?

We just had our largest fundraiser of the year -our Walk, where we had a Celebration of Life for the patients we served from April 2021 to May 2022, and everyone had the opportunity to release a butterfly in memory of a loved one. 

Earlier this month, I stopped by one of my favorite hidden Garrett County gems, the Shawnee Trading Post. Located on Sand Flat Road in Deer Park, Shawnee Trading Post is one of the most unique, strange, and mesmerizing places you'll ever come across in the whole county.

This place is an endless wonderland of curiosities, like the towering wooden bull rearing on its hind legs surrounded by other carvings of buffalos and Native Americans and horses and a white-gloved butler with bushy eyebrows. The next time you can't find the right life-size buffalo statue or a giant gorilla sculpture, just stop in at Shawnee, they'll have what you're looking for!

During my last visit, there was a Gigantic Goofy Alligator holding out his arms as if to tell me I should buy both



Garrett County Arts Council Spotlight: *Funding!*

The Garrett County Arts Council (GCAC) held its annual membership meeting on Friday, June 17, at the Oakland offices. The party was attended by approximately 90 guests, and the annual business meeting during which funded grants were announced took place. The GCAC awarded a total of \$46,475 in grant funds to 15 arts organizations, non-profits, schools, and local governments. Of the 15 awards, one grantee was new to GCAC funding. The organization also awarded 10 Independent Artist Awards totaling \$6,050 and one Emergency Artist Relief Fund award of \$500. The total Community Arts Development Grantmaking impact was \$53,025, as announced by Kathy Beachler, executive director of GCAC.

The grant approvals were released in May and officially announced at Friday's event. The meeting included music by local favorite Buffalo Run, performing on the Front Page Stage. Numerous artisans had booths set up as well, selling their created wares. The artisans stayed on Saturday as, taking part in the town of Oakland's Kickoff to Summer.

The organizations allotted General Operating Grants this year are the Barn Quilt Association of Garrett County, Garrett Lakes Arts Festival, and Spruce Forest Artisan Village. All three organizations provide a wide range of arts and arts endeavors that enrich the county in so many ways, Beachler said.

Those receiving Program/Project Grant Awards are as follows: Broad Ford Elementary School, Deep Creek Lake Lions Club, Friendsville Days Inc., Garrett Choral Society, Garrett Community Concert Band, Grantsville Lions Club, Highland Festival of Garrett County, Oakland Heritage Community Foundation, Our Town Theatre, Southern High School Theatre Program, Town of Kitzmiller, and Town of Mountain Lake Park.

Independent Artist Awards were allotted to a number of local artists in music and visual art. Those receiving grants in music are Sean Beachy, Moe Turrentine, Gino Mauricci, Fred Jacoby, Matt Eary, Rick Milne, and Stephan Moylan. Those receiving grants in visual art are Francis Precht, Caroline Blizzard, and Julie Turrentine.

GCAC also awarded one requested Emergency Artist Relief Fund Award of \$500 (Awardee is kept anonymous).

Beachler noted that all grant applications were reviewed and scored by a group of six independent jurors from the community/region.

The funding is vital for these organizations and individuals, according to some of the recipients. Lindy Moebs, the president of the Garrett Choral Society, said that both the choral group and the Garrett Community Concert Band, of which she is a board member, depend heavily on Arts Council funding.

"Expenses for a non-profit aren't what people think," Moebs said. "Folks ask me why we sell tickets if we're 'non-profit.' They expect our concerts to be fundraisers for some other cause, as if we pull in the



bucks by putting on a show. Sadly, that's not the case."

In addition to the prices of music and to cover the small stipend for conductor Sean Beachy, the band also has funded \$15,000+ in scholarships for its student band over the years.

"The percentage of our expenses covered by ticket sales is pretty much next to nothing, especially for the band," Moebs said. "Donations from private individuals is not a huge amount, either. So GCAC funding is truly vital for both organizations, and we appreciate it."

Mary Mateer, the executive director of the Garrett Lakes Arts Festival, also had words of gratitude for the annual support of the GCAC.

"The Arts Council provides grant funding that has been essential to GLAF programming for over 20 years. GLAF has been able to bring a wide selection of quality programming to our community due to these funds," Mateer said. "In addition, the partnership with the arts community that the Arts Council provides has been another valuable resource for GLAF."

Don Sincell, an organizer of the Town of Mountain Lake Park's Victorian Chautauqua for which the GCAC grant will help fund, said the money helps to keep the weekend celebration free for guests.

"Multiple art forms, including music, drama, dance, writing, and craft arts, can be enjoyed at our Victorian Chautauqua Festival and VC Writers Workshop, so we believe our festival is a perfect fit for the criteria needed to be awarded a grant from the Arts Council," Sincell said. "We also take great pride in the fact that every single program at our weekend festival is free of charge to our guests, and such

Dragon Boat Festival Slated for August 27

Dove Center is bringing creative fundraising to the forefront, after weathering two consecutive cancellations of their major fundraiser, Festival of Trees. The cancellations came at a time when COVID had created a perfect storm for domestic violence and other forms of abuse. The number of clients served increased 32%, and the number of services provided to those clients increased 135%. To help counter this, Broadford Lake will come alive with the sounds of plunging paddles on Saturday, August 27, for the first annual Mountain Maryland Dragon Boat Festival. Victorian Chautauqua Returns!



The Victorian Chautauqua will unfurl its second year in the Historic District of Mountain Lake Park on July 9 & 10, 2022. The weekend following the 4th of July marks the annual celebration of the town's history as Maryland's original Chautauqua that was established along the B&O Railroad in 1881. With free admission and parking, this family-friendly festival has quickly grown to become a premier summer event in Garrett County.

The festival features live historical performances, music, lectures, activities, food, artisans, antique market, the Ticket Office Museum, Historic District Trolley Bus tours, and an entire program dedicated to children.

The 40 by 80-foot Martin Tent in Leo Martin Memorial Park will house historical portrayals and live music. The Burlington Tent of equal size will house lectures and live music. The Deaconess Tent will present Kid-Tauqua programming for children which has been generously funded by Samantha Funding the Arts. The Historic Assembly Hall adds a perfect venue for some presentations requiring an indoor space.

A special kick-off fundraiser, Dinner on the Diner, will be held Friday, July 8th from 6:00 PM until dark. A special menu has been created by Chef David Haynes who with 40 years of experience has been an executive chef or owner of several notable restaurants in Fredericksburg, Virginia. The theme is centered on railroad dining cars with three meat dishes, one vegetarian, and one vegan entree from which to choose. Tickets are available online with a link conveniently featured in an orange banner at the top of the website. The proceeds benefit the Victorian Chautauqua program.

Saturday's programming features performances beginning at 11:00 with the controversial U.S. President, Warren G. Harding portrayed by Bill Grant. Traveling from New Jersey, Keith Hanley will present the acclaimed agricultural scientist George Washington Carver, and renowned journalist Nellie Bly will be reenacted by the award-winning actress JoAnn Peterson. Live music will include songs from the Civil War by songwriter Philip Gerard, The West Liberty World Music Ensemble with African drum workshop and steel drums concert led by Dr. Mitch Greco, and from New



York, violin and piano with Dale Stuckenbruck and Haewon Kim playing works from the turn of the last century. Stuckenbruck has also perfected playing an ordinary hand saw with a bow which he will delightfully demonstrate. A unique storytelling duo called Crankies uses shadow puppetry in a delightful return to Victorian-era entertainment.

For youngsters, "Ranger Champ" will present campfire singalongs with a special guest appearance from Smokey Bear. Jo Ann Dadisman will dazzle kids with an interactive show called Puppets & Play. Between shows, the little ones can participate in making bubbles, face painting, tie-dying, and make & take projects. All the children's programs and activities are free of charge.

Saturday will also include a Model T Showcase by the Mason Dixon Ts. Certain drivers will be offering Historic District joy rides in authentic vehicles from the early 1900s. The chapter president, Bill Ramsey, will share his passion for America's most popular car under the Burlington Tent on Saturday as the showcase opens. Attendees will also delight in seeing Brian Birkner wiz by on his high-wheel bicycle. He will be demonstrating this early bicycle model and be providing a lecture about cycling history on Saturday.

As the daytime activites come to a close, the TeenPunk Silent Disco will begin at 7:30 and last until dark and is funded by Edward Jones. Admission is free but limited to youth that include rising freshmen through 2022 high school graduates. Sound Fusion Entertainment will provide the sound and transmit music to 100 LED lighted headset from SoundOff Entertainment (first come, first served). When the headsets are on, the dance party is on. Otherwise, it's silent. Games and prizes will round out the event, and a light show will emerge as the sun goes down to make for a spectacular teen social event of the summer. More details can be found online.

Throughout the entire weekend, food vendors will be serving up festival favorites including D's Eats pulled pork barbeque, grilled cheese, and Italian subs. The Win-

One of Deep Creek Lake's favorite stops, Lakeside Creamery, will hand scoop ice cream in cups and cones. The FIRST Robotics Team's authentic hand-pressed lemonade and Rotary



French fries are well-known local favorites. Attendees should arrive hungry since food will be served throughout the day and include lunch and dinner menu items.

Artisans will be displaying handmade pottery from Deep Creek Pottery, jewelry from Wirestorm Creations, textiles from Crimson Shamrock Ranch, quilling from Practiquils, and wood carving from Bowl Weevil Works. Coun-

try Parson Honey will offer an array of bee products and Meadow Mountain Hemp will share their full line of locally grown CBD products including tinctures, topicals, and edibles. Featured artists will turn back time. Lauren Muney will take commissions for hand-cut silhouette profile portraits made popular at the turn of the last century, and wet plate photographer Chris Jones will accept commissions for tintype or glass plate photos, an early photographic technique that captures modern-day as if it were 100 years ago.

An expanded antique market by Carriage House Antiques will also be offering a curated collection for anyone looking to treat their Victorian fever. Treasures large and small will be on display and available for sale. Local deliveries can be arranged for larger pieces.

The fun continues through Sunday beginning at noon. Notable Smithsonian Scholar and actor, Mary Ann Jung will be performing her favorite historical figure, Clara Barton, best known for founding the American Red Cross. A lecture about Custer's Last Stand will be presented by acclaimed author and historian, Steven French. A secular Ol' Fashion Hymn Sing will be held in the historic Assembly Hall building, and the first woman to cross the English Channel, Harriet Quimby, will be portrayed by actor Sara Sincell.

A unique portrayal by Sallie Wooddell Stuart of Julia Ruhl, a former Mountain Lake Park resident, will bring to light the newly discovered influence Ruhl had on the women's suffrage movement and passing the 19th Amendment that granted women the right to vote. A marker dedication honoring Ruhl's suffrage contributions will follow the performance at her beautiful former cottage on G Street.

The second annual Beard & Mustache Contest will crown a new 2022 Hairyman champion. All contestants can register throughout the weekend for the chance to
