

Milk Carton Box from the Carton Maker

This is a great way to get even more out of your carton maker board. The following are the dimensions for the three different sizes of carton holders.

For the small:

Cut one 7 3/4 x 7 3/4 inch piece of card stock.

Cut two 4 x 7 1/4 inch pieces of card stock for the handles.

For the medium:

Cut one 7 3/4 x 7 3/4 inch piece of card stock.

Cut two 4 x 8 1/4 inch pieces of card stock for the handles.

For the large:

Cut one 7 3/4 x 7 3/4 inch piece of card stock.

Cut two 4 x 9 1/4 inch pieces of card stock for the handles.

Score the 7 3/4 inch square piece using the Carton Maker Board by placing the card stock into the board in the top left corner and score it at 5 and 6 score marks, turn and repeat on all 4 sides.

Cut away the excess sides and leave a tab for assembling the box together. Keep the longer off cuts so that you can use them to steady the handle.

Take the two handle pieces, place them in the board in the top left corner and score using the 6 score mark.

Cut on an opening for the handle using a circle or oval punch or die from your stash.
