We particularly invite submissions of articles focusing on the following topics:

- Hybrid criminal tribunals;
- International criminal law and environmental protection.

Articles focusing on other topics are equally welcome. Contributions can be submitted in English or German. We further welcome conference reports, book reviews (upon request), and case notes. The **deadline** for submissions of contributions is the **15<sup>th</sup> of July 2023**.

All articles are subject to a double-blind peer-review process by the editorial and advisory board.
