#### **WE HEAR GOD'S WORD**

SCRIPTURE READING EXODUS 34:5-10

<sup>5</sup>The LORD came down in the cloud. He took His stand there with Moses and proclaimed the name of the LORD. <sup>6</sup>The LORD passed by in front of him and proclaimed: "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, and overflowing with mercy and truth, <sup>7</sup> maintaining mercy for thousands, forgiving guilt and rebellion and sin. He will by no means clear the guilty. He calls their children and their children's children to account for the guilt of the fathers, even to the third and the fourth generation."

<sup>8</sup> Moses quickly bowed to the ground and worshipped. <sup>9</sup> He said, "If I have now found favor in Your sight, LORD, please let the LORD go along with us. Although this is a stiff-necked people, pardon our guilt and our sin, and accept us as Your possession." 10 The LORD said, "See, I am making a covenant. In the presence of all your people I will do marvelous things such as have never been created anywhere on earth or in

any nation. So, all the people who are around you will see the work of the LORD. For it is an awe-inspiring thing that I will do for you."

## SCRIPTURE READING MATTHEW 16:13-20

13 When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" <sup>14</sup> They said, "Some say John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." <sup>15</sup> He said to them, "**But you, who do you say that I am?**" <sup>16</sup> Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." <sup>17</sup> Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. <sup>18</sup> And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of hell will not overpower it. <sup>19</sup> I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." <sup>20</sup> Then He commanded the disciples not to tell anyone that He was the Christ.


