

It is with pleasure that we invite your students to create and submit artwork to EVPL's Black History Month High School Art Show, to take place at EVPL Central throughout February 2024.

All high school art students in Vanderburgh County are invited to express their personal ideas, thoughts and feelings about Black History Month through an individual art piece.

EVPL's annual reading program theme for 2024 is Read – Discover – Play, and we are asking that **students' individual entries also relate to one of these three words.** While this won't be a juried art show, we will be welcoming votes for the Community Choice Award in each of the three themes, with prizes for all three winners. Voting will take place from the beginning of the exhibit until the art show's special reception planned in early February.

The students' artwork will be displayed in cases placed in EVPL Central's main lobby, and **submissions are due no later than January 19.**

Here are additional details and guidelines:

- Art should be two-dimensional, to the degree needed to be able to hang inside a display case.
 - EVPL staff will add mounting hardware as needed, being careful to not affect the integrity of the piece.
- Submissions should include the following on the registration form below:
 - Student name, school, and age
 - Title of the piece
 - Specific theme (of three above)
 - Chosen medium

Submissions will be brought to **EVPL Central by 4 p.m. on Friday, January 19.** However, if there are particularly large items and/or volumes of submissions, we can arrange pickup at a Vanderburgh County school that week.

**Participants accept that the registered art will be publicly exhibited at EVPL Central.*
