



Stationery Gift Set

I am so glad you have purchased our gift set instructions. I really believe you will want to make this for everyone on your gift list! Imagine making them for different occasions or making them personalized with monograms and initials.

If you are taking this class live with us on August 21-23 please be sure to have all your prep work done before class. We will pace the class based on all cuts being made before we start work to allow us to finish in three sessions.

Ok, first your supplies:

I am using study cardstock for the base, I suggest 49 and Market 12 x 12 in black or white. But if you can't use that the base card needs to be at least 100 lb cover stock. Can you make it lighter? Sure but you will not see the same results.

- 7 sheets 12x12 solid heavy weight cardstock
- 10 sheets of 12x12 decorator paper to cover (I suggest a paper pack so you can coordinating options)
- 2 sets of strong magnets (I suggest large Basic Grey magnets)
- 18" of coordinating ribbon
- 1 3x3 Post It note set
- 1 5x8 legal pad

Tools for the job are:

- Trimmer
- Scissors
- Scoreboard
- Bone folder
- Glue (wet and sticky tape)
- Ruler
- Corner rounder punch

Let's get cutting and prepping!

Please do not attempt to assemble without taking the class, we will only need to cut the pieces to have them ready to score and assemble once we start the live stream.

Solid Cardstock Cuts:

- ☐ (1) 12x12 cardstock (the base starts here)
- ☐ (2) $5 \frac{3}{4} \times 5$
- ☐ (2) $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 5$
- ☐ (1) $9 \frac{1}{8} \times 7 \frac{5}{8}$
- ☐ (2) $4 \frac{5}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$
- ☐ (1) $10 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{3}{4}$
- ☐ (1) 10 x 3 piece of cardstock
- ☐ (1) $10 \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ piece of cardstock
- ☐ (1) $4 \frac{3}{4} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ piece of cardstock
- ☐ (1) $6 \frac{7}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{4}$ Piece of cardstock
- ☐ (1) $11 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ piece of cardstock
- ☐ (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ piece of cardstock
- ☐ (1) $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ piece of cardstock
- ☐ (1) $1 \frac{3}{4} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ piece of cardstock

Designer Paper Cardstock Cuts:

In the following photos I will do my best to show you exactly where each designer paper is going to be placed so that you can make the appropriate cuts. I will section the designer paper cuts to match the part of the project you are prepping for:

Outside Box lid



- Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 8 \frac{7}{8}$ (front and back)
- Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{8}$ (sides)
- Cut (1) $2 \frac{3}{8} \times 8 \frac{7}{8}$ (top)

Outside Box body



- Cut (2) $2 \frac{3}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ (sides)
- Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ (sides)
- Cut (1) $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{3}{4}$ (front)
- Cut (1) $8 \frac{3}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ (back)

Inside box back and sides



- Cut (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{3}{4}$ inside back decorator paper
- Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ Inside sides decorator paper

Inside door flap



- Cut (2) $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{4}$ Side flaps inside
- Cut (1) $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{3}{4}$ Bottom Flap inside

Dividers flaps



- Cut (1) $2 \frac{3}{4} \times 8 \frac{3}{4}$ 1st divider decorator paper
- Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 8 \frac{3}{4}$ 2nd divider decorator paper
- Cut (1) $1 \frac{3}{4} \times 8 \frac{3}{4}$ 3rd divider decorator paper

Post It Holder



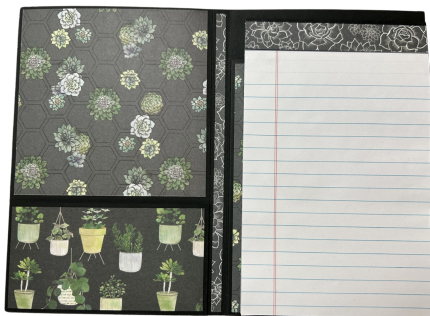
- Cut (1) 3×3 piece of decorator cardstock to cover the top of the post it notepad holder.

Postage Envelope



- Cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ pieces of decorator cardstock.
- Cut (1) $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ pieces of decorator cardstock.

Legal Pad Cover



- Cut (2) $5 \frac{1}{4} \times 8 \frac{1}{4}$ Front and Back covers
- Cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{4} \times 8 \frac{1}{4}$ spine strips
- Cut (1) $5 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ left pocket cover
- Cut (1) $6 \frac{3}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ legal pad pocket cover
- Cut (1) $5 \frac{1}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ inside left above pocket
