Prep and Supplies!

We will be making two cards and one scrapbook layout. I will share with you the supplies you need to complete the projects with me as well as what items I plan to use specifically. You don't need to use exactly what I am using, use your stash!

Each month we will use what we like to call our Make It Kit. This is a list of supplies we typically use for all projects so you will want to have all of these on hand to create.

Make It Kit

Trimmer

Scissors (big and small)

Pokey Tool

Pencil

Stamp blocks or a stamp platform of your choice

Scoreboard and Bone Folder

Ruler

Glue (wet, sticky tape and foam)

Cloth to clean up messes

Any tools you routinely work with as well.

SNACKS!

You will find specific supplies listed in each projects instruction page.

For best participation, we suggest having two screens. One to watch and one to chat, for example, use your computer or TV to watch the projects and your phone or tablet to chat in the livestream. This is not necessary but it is helpful.

Made It Society is not a class so it does not function as our live classes do, this is more of a Make-a-long so we will just craft together and have fun! Class will open at 10am CST. Not early like our traditional online classes do.


Sneaky Peaky Frog Card

This is a sketch of the card we will be making in March Made It Society. This is only a sample sketch, I will be using the frog from our recent Toad Ya! Stamp set but you can search your stash of the perfect image or ephemera.

We will be adding some fun details to this card that you can't see in the black and white sketch!

Supplies:

- Make It Kit
- 1- A2 White Card Base (5 1/2 x 4 1/4 when folded, portrait with a left side fold or top fold)
- 1- 4 1/4 x 5 1/4 inch white card mat (notice this unusual size? It is the size we need for this card)
- Stamp or focal ephemera, I am using the frog. I will also color my frog before class, you may want to do so as well.
- Ink to stamp images and or sentiments. I will be using black ink.
- Green ink for edge inking (I am using green, you could use any color that coordinates)
- Ink blending tool of choice. I will use Waffle Flower Blending Brush.





TOP TIP!

I always suggest you watch the project before you make it. But, I know you want to craft along so...don't put too much pressure on yourself at first. Consider the first one we make together your practice sample card. Let go and have fun!

Fun Fold Cathedral Window Cross Card

For this fun card, I am going to mix a card I made last year with the Cathedral Window Fold to make a cool 3D cross effect that becomes a standing card so the recipient can display it for the the season.

NOTES: I will be using Easter cardstock.



Supplies:

- Make It Kit
- 1-A2 base cut $5 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ scored at 2, 4, $4 \frac{1}{2}$ and $6 \frac{1}{2}$
- 1- 1 x 4 inch piece of white cardstock
- 1- 1 x 3 inch piece of cardstock
- 1- 1x1 square of study cardstock to use as your template.
- 6- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ half inch circles, these need to be double sided decorator card stock. I suggest a patterned front and a more solid back. See the sketch as an example. They need to coordinate with your panels below.
- 6- 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch pieces of patterned cardstock. These pieces go where the green is on this card sketch and on the ends of the back. They can all match or be different from each other. I will be doing two matching on the ends, two matching in the middle and two matching on the back.
- I will using our new stamp set called Alleluia for my sentiment. You will need ink in two colors, one light and one dark. Your ink will need to coordinate with the card stock you chose.

Scrapbook Layout

I will be making a 12 x 12 scrapbook layout. As I make it I will show you how you can re size it to fit whatever album size you are using. This months layout for me will be a baby shower layout. Using a picture from a recent baby shower we held for my DIL.

You will be able to edit this layout to fit any photo you have, mine will be a 6x4 photo and I am only doing one photo on this layout.

Supplies:

- 1- 12 x 12 inch piece of cardstock to be the base mat to the layout on.
- 2 - 5 3/4 x 11 3/4 inch pieces of decorator paper. I will be using two different patterns that will coordinate with each other.
- 1- 4 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch piece of dark coordinating solid color cardstock.
- 1- 4 1/4 x 6 1/4 inch piece of light coordinating solid color cardstock.
- 1 - 9 1/2 x 4 1/2 inch piece of dark coordinating solid color cardstock.
- 1- 9 1/4 x 4 1/4 inch piece of light coordinating solid color cardstock.

Misc ephemera, bling, trims, extra photos etc. Use what matches your them and will add your stylet to the layout.
