We will be making two cards and one scrapbook layout. I will share with you the supplies you need to complete the projects with me as well as what items I plan to use specifically. You don't need to use exactly what I am using, use your stash! For this month, I am not sure exactly what papers I will use but you can bet it is some of our new stock, I am loving all the new papers we have in stock!

Each month we will use what we like to call our Make It Kit. This is a list of supplies we typically use for all projects so you will want to have all of these on hand to create.

## Make It Kit

Trimmer

Scissors (big and small)

Pokey Tool

Pencil

Scoreboard and Bone Folder

Ruler

Glue (wet, sticky tape and foam)

Cloth to clean up messes

Any tools you routinely work with as well.

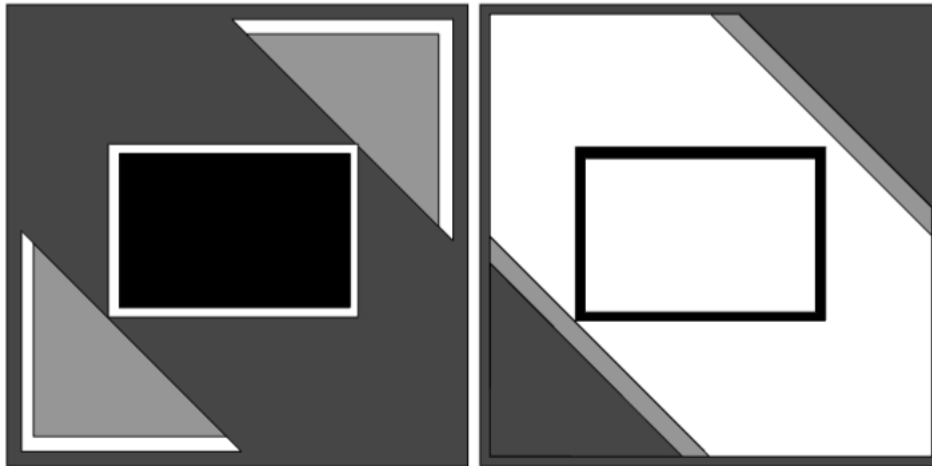
SNACKS!

# On Point Scrapbook Double Page Layout



This double page layout is so fun, it uses 4 12x12 pages in a unique and coordinating way. I really think you will enjoy this easy but eye catching layout.

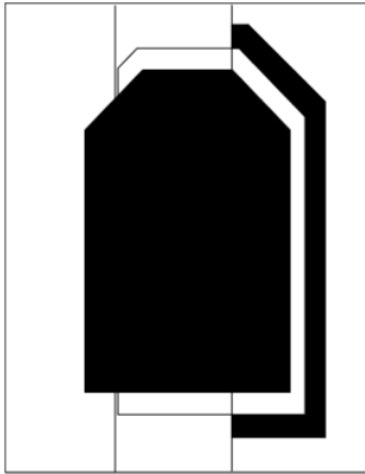
You will want to add ephemera

Supplies:

- Make It Kit (as listed on the first page)
- 2- 12x12 pieces of cardstock as your base.
- 2 pieces of 12x12 cardstock that coordinate and compliment each other.
- 2- photo mat pieces that measure 4 1/4 x 6 1/4.
- 2- 4 x 6 photos of your choice.

To help you choose papers, in the diagrams above you will see that all the white is one 12 x 12 page, all the light gray is one 12 x 12 page and the dark gray is another 12 x 12 page. The photo mats do not come from these pages, they are cut separately.

# Nesting Fold Card (Two Cards in ONE!)



This fun take on an accordion fold takes one piece of 12 x 12 and creates two very interesting cards that I would consider fun fold cards.

You will add the sentiment of your choice, for me I will be using our newest stamp set called Our God Reigns. I will be using the large girl and umbrella image. You may want to go ahead and cut out the free svg and color it to match your chosen card stock. I will be prepping my image beforehand.

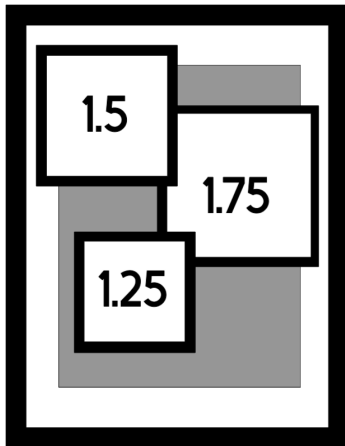
Supplies:

- Make It Kit (as listed on the first page)
- 1- 12x12 piece of double sided decorator cardstock.
- 1- 3 1/2 x 4 3/4 piece of coordinating solid color cardstock (bottom tag)
- 1- 3 x 4 1/4 piece of coordinating solid color cardstock (middle tag)
- 1- 2 1/2 x 3 3/4 piece of coordinating solid color cardstock (top tag)

To help you choose papers, notice that the top tag shaped layer and the bottom tag shaped layer are the same color. I will be stamping on my top layer therefore I will not be using black cardstock, I used that in the graphic so that you could clearly see the layers.

Also, you can use any nested shape here, I chose tag shaped because you don't need any special tools to make those.

# Gallery Wall Card



What if we took the idea of a gallery wall and our fun new Silly Goose stamp set and create what will feel like a fun photo shoot of our Goose? This one is fun and easy and as always, it's a great way to dig into your scraps!

We will be stamping the goose's many faces on the first layer of our squares, I will be using a white or light colored card stock so that I can just stamp directly on them.

Supplies:

- Make It Kit (as listed on the first page)
- 1 A2 Card Base
- 1- 3 3/4 x 5 inch mat layer
- 1-3 x 4 mat layer
- For our squares: 1 2 inch square mat and a 1 3/4 inch square top layer to stamp.
  - 1-1 3/4 inch square mat and a 1 1/2 inch square top layer to stamp.
  - 1-1 1/2 inch square mat and a 1 1/4 inch square top layer to stamp.

You can design your layout anyway you like, I will be matching my image mat layers to my card base.
