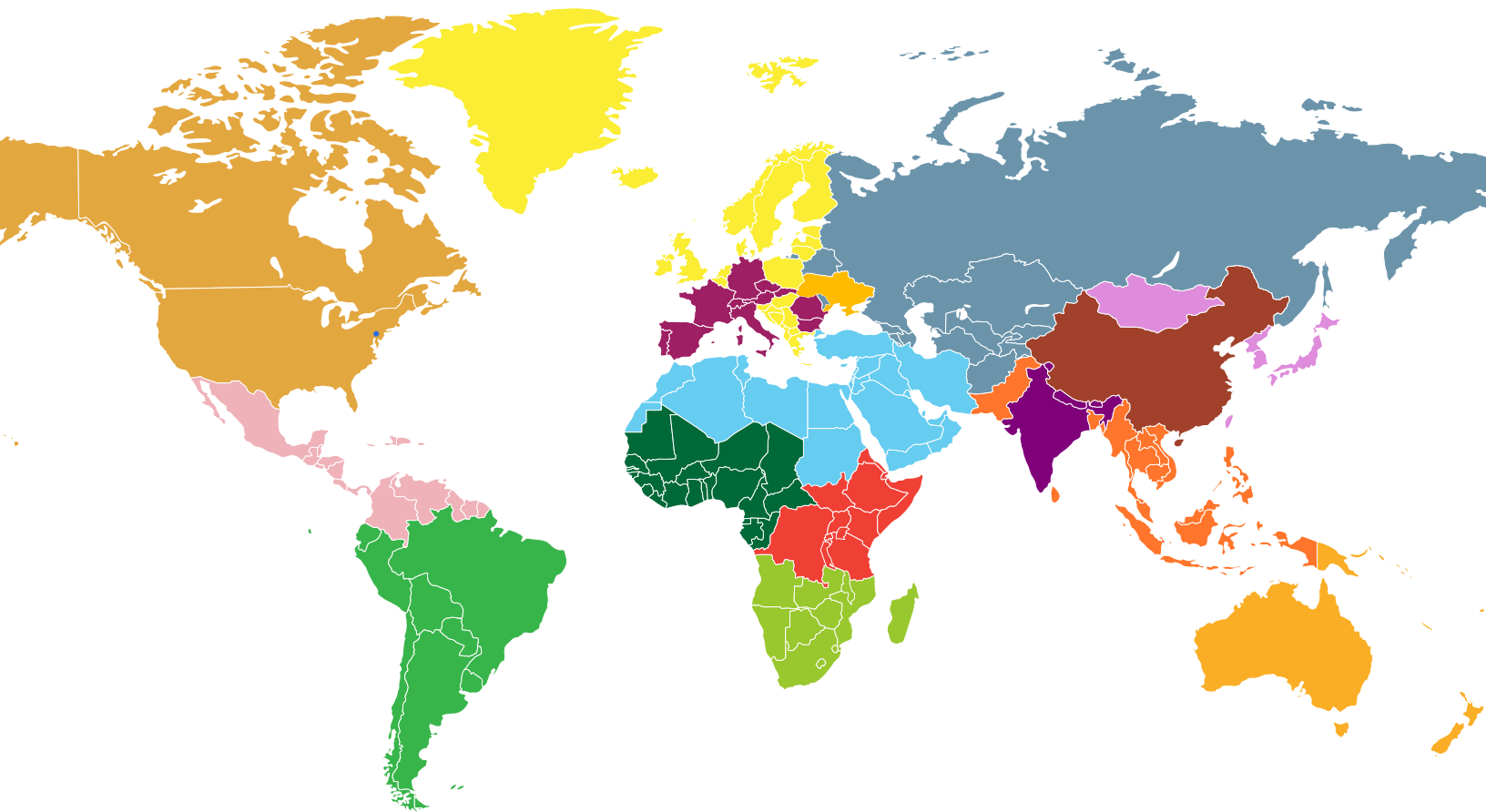

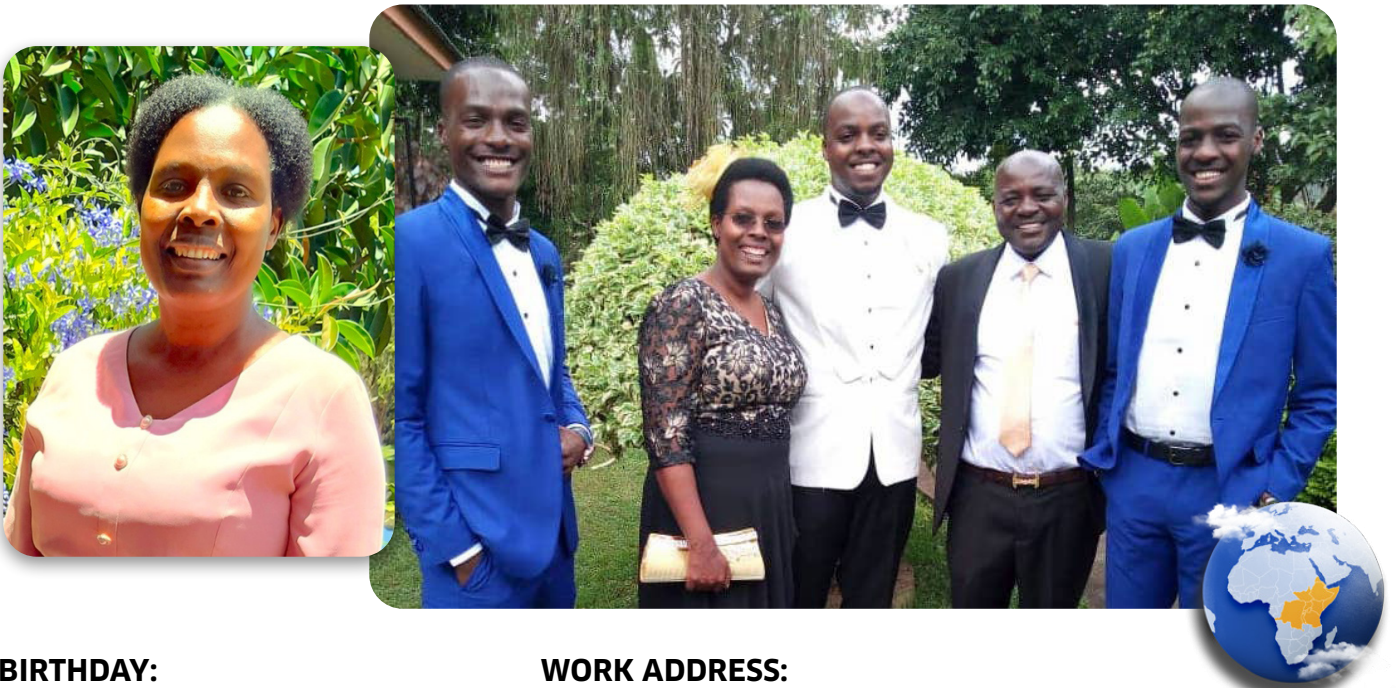

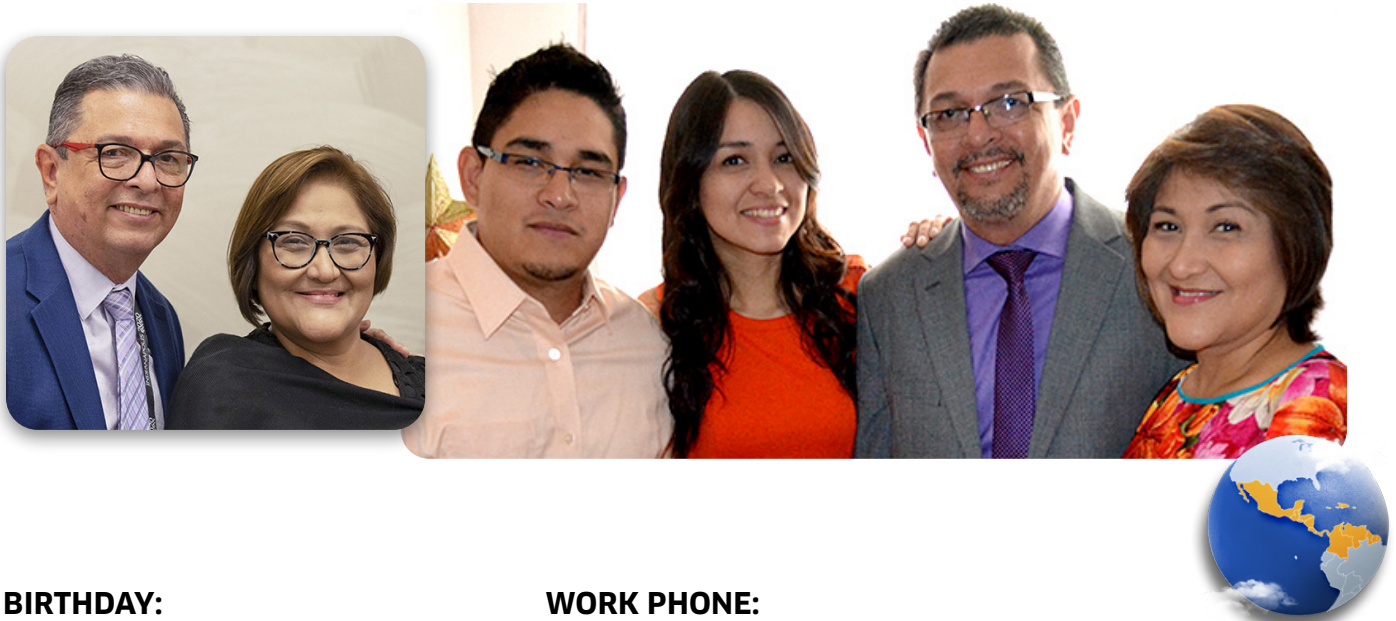

COURSE CURRICULUM AND REQUIREMENTS:

- 10 Modules consisting of 50 hours of lectures and independent learning assignments.
- Each Module requires a total of 5 hours: 3 hours of lecture/seat time and 2 hours of independent learning consisting of recommended readings found at the end of each Module.
- The independent learning requirements for Module 5 include developing and presenting a family strengthening seminar of about 45 minutes.
- The LCP curriculum is divided into two levels: Level 1 (Modules 1-5) and Level 2 (Modules 6-10).

- Certificates will be sent to the Division Director's office to distribute to the applicable Union Director(s) to present to participants who have completed the course curriculum requirements for each of the two levels.
- Individuals who participate in all the lectures for the 10 modules comprising Level 1 or Level 2 but were unable to complete the course curriculum requirements will receive a certificate of attendance from the General Conference's Adventist Family Ministries.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES:

Participants will:

- Have an overarching understanding of families within the context of God's creation intent and His redemptive purpose in ministering to families.
- Have a knowledge of the content and processes of each Module of the Family Ministries Leadership Curriculum to assist in developing and implementing a Family Ministries plan.
- Demonstrate leadership skill levels in family life education and enrichment that are adequate for facilitating particular events. Know and maintain the appropriate boundary that separates counseling (therapy) and family life education and enrichment, and respect the qualifications required for each. Live and minister with the highest ethical standards and within the scope of their qualifications.
- Identify available family life resources and programs. Assess their compatibility or incompatibility with Scripture, the Writings of Ellen G. White and Adventist perspectives on the family.
- Support pastors in family approaches to evangelism and engage in the evangelization and discipling of families for Christ.

HISTORY AND SYMBOLISM OF ADVENTIST FAMILY MINISTRIES LOGO

The branding representation of Adventist Family Ministries has always been focused on expressing the wide reach of care for families across the world in and out of the Seventh-day Adventist Church.

After the Church Ministries (CM) Department was terminated at the 1995 General Conference Session in Utrecht, Netherlands, each ministry department that made up CM, including Adventist Family Ministries (AFM), became a stand alone department. With Ron and Karen Flowers elected at the 1995 GC Session as director and associate director of the “new” ministry, a logotype representing the nuclear family was commissioned and used from 1996-2010. At the 2010 General Conference Session in Atlanta, Georgia, Willie and Elaine Oliver were elected as director and associate director of AFM and a logotype representing the new mission and vision of AFM was commissioned and used from 2010-2015. After the 2015 General Conference Session in San Antonio, Texas, to launch the centennial celebration of AFM taking place in October 2019, a modified logo was introduced to be used during the 2015-2020 quinquennium. In 2020 the General Conference issued a rebranding of its logotype and Adventist Family Ministries followed-suit in order to portray the consolidated branding of the World Church.

AUTHORIZATION TO USE THE LOGO

The logo is the property of Adventist Family Ministries of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists. Adventist Family Ministries authorizes its use at all levels of church organization. The logo icon may be used with the words Adventist Family Ministries in English, Spanish, or any other language in which the church operates, and in the colors offered here or other colors as may be fitting to different cultures and/or people groups.
