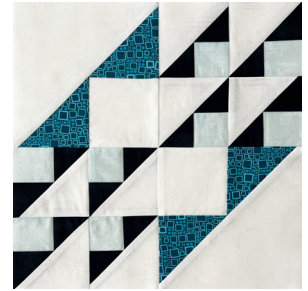

See Saw adds some interest to your block collection. Using only Shaded Four Patch technique in two different sizes, this exciting block can be made in no time at all. Put the blocks together to make some appealing designs.

Note: You can find the directions you need to make this block in the instructions for the Tucker Trimmer® I tool. You will also need the Shaded Four Patch Technique Sheet. Note: For the 16" block, it is recommended to use the Tucker Trimmer® III for the unit trim downs.

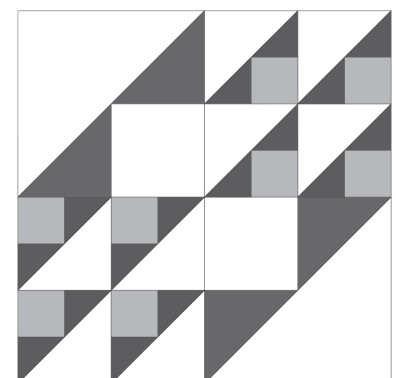
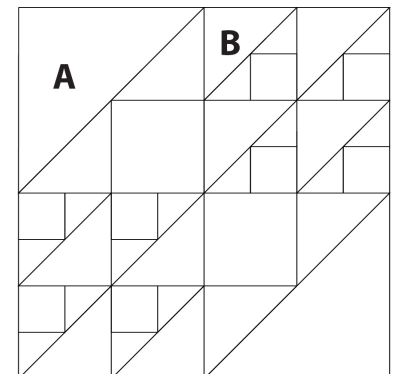
A: Large Shaded Four Patch

Cutting Instructions: Per Block

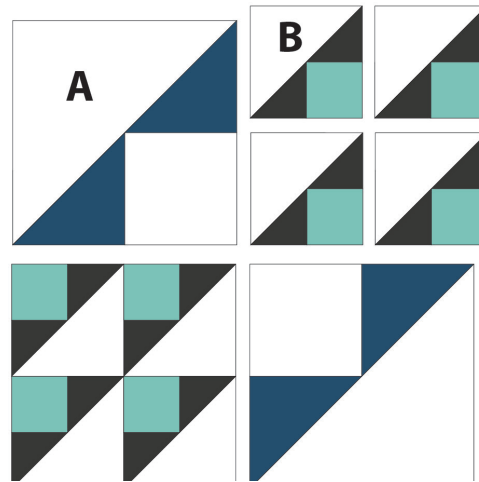
Unit Name and # of Units	8"	12"	16"
A: Large Shaded Four Patch 2 Units	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size	6" Finished 6 ½" Cut size	8" Finished 8 ½" Cut size
B: Small Shaded Four Patch 8 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size



Block Assembly

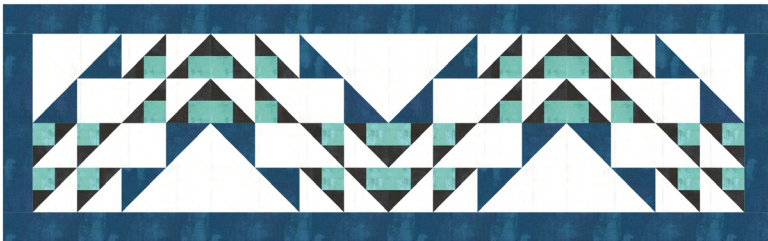
1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams open.

Make (1) Block.

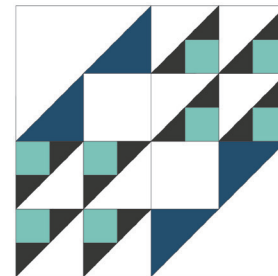

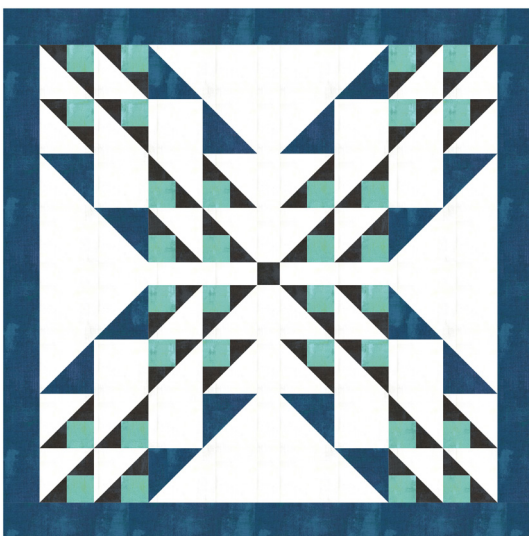
