The Migrating South block uses the Flock of Birds Technique, Half-Square Triangles, and Flying Geese to create the illusion of birds flying south for the winter.

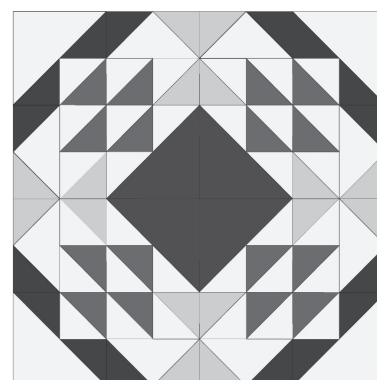
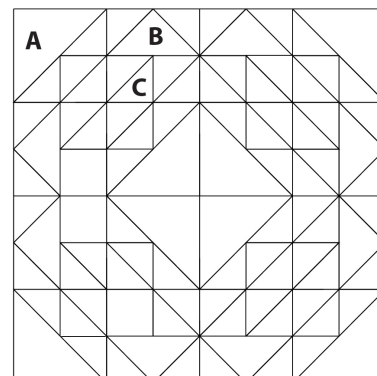
B: Flying Geese

Cutting Instructions: Per Block

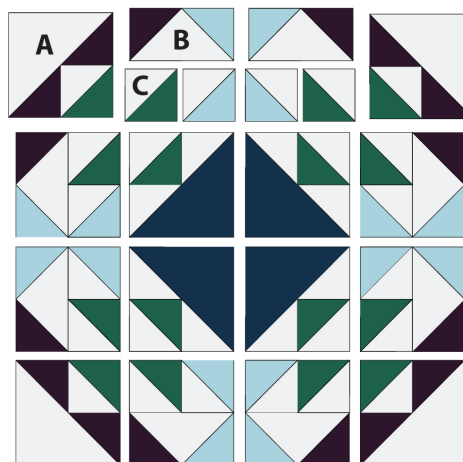
Unit Name and # of Units	8"	12"	16"
A: Flock of Birds 8 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
B: Flying Geese 8 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" Cut size	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" Cut size
C: Half Square Triangle 16 Units	1" Finished 1 ½" Cut size	1 ½" Finished 2" Cut size	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size



Block Assembly

1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams open.

Make (1) Block.

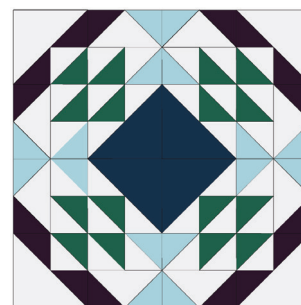
