







Cutting Instructions: Per Block



A: Double Popped Flock of Birds 4 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
B: Double Popped Flock of Birds 4 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
C: Double Popped Flock of Birds 4 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
Finished Size/Cut Away Size on Corner Pop® III	2" Finished/Cut Away size	3" Finished/Cut Away size	4" Finished/Cut Away size


Block Assembly

- 1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
- 2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
- Stitch the rows together, press seams open.Make (1) Block.




