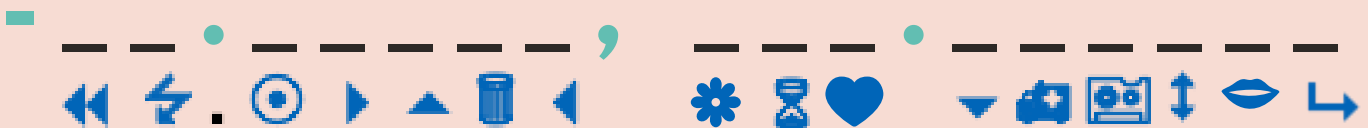


**MONOPOLY: TMI**

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. On the next page, you'll find a series of images that show pairs of dice. Each pair corresponds to **Dice Rolls** in a game of Monopoly using the standard board.
2. Starting on the GO square, move your team's imaginary token the number of spaces indicated on the dice beside the roll number ( R# ). For example, R1 shows dice for your first roll adding up to 9 (6+3) so you'll move 9 spaces from 'Go', which takes you to Connecticut Avenue.
3. Once there, go to the **Questions** and answer the question associated with that square (Q1 in the example). The number in parentheses after the question (3 in the example) indicates the number of digits in the answer. So, in the example, you know the first answer is between 100 and 999. Record your answers on the **Answer Sheet**.
4. Move your token as if you were actually playing Monopoly. (i.e. R2 takes you five spaces from where you left off after your first roll. Do NOT start over from the GO square).
  - *The answers are not inter-related so you do not have to resolve the question for one square before you can "roll the dice" and head to your next square.*
5. Questions are intentionally written in a convoluted manner to test your ability to comprehend and process information quickly, discarding what's not needed to find a solution.
  - *Note that NO zeroes have been filled in so they may show up in your answers to the questions.*
6. Once you have rolled the dice 13 times and answered all the required questions, **replace the symbols in the Mystery Coordinate below.**
7. Type the coordinate (note the negative sign) into Google Maps, change into Street View mode and follow the instructions below:

**MYSTERY COORDINATE:**

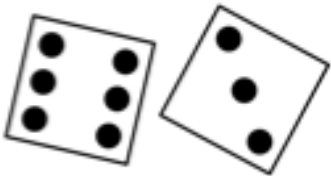

**MONOPOLY: TMI - QUESTIONS**

**Q1.** The capital city of the state referenced in this property name once was home to an NHL team that, in 1997, moved 840 km to the southwest. One of the best players in the history of the club during its time in that first city was a Calgary-born skater who, at the conclusion of his on-ice career, moved back to Calgary to take on a job covering the Flames as a radio analyst, retiring from that job in 2013. He also could accurately be referred to using the screen name of the host of a famous television program geared towards children. How many assists did this player-turned-broadcaster record in his 484 game NHL career? (3)

**Q2.** A famous British athlete who has the same first name as this property won the centenary year edition of one of the most famous tournaments in her sport, which happened to be held the same year of the Silver Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II. The day she won that tournament was the same day a boy who would grow up to be a famous Calgary sporting icon was born in Edmonton. That baby was given a unique set of middle names by his parents, one of which should be instantly recognizable to anyone with a passing interest in music. How many letters are in the name of the city in the southeastern United States in which that music legend was born? (1)

**Q3.** There's a cartoon flightless bird who is always well-dressed that was popular in the 1960s that has the same first name as the property you just landed on. Said bird's best friend at the zoo where they lived has a name that rhymes with the last name of the guy who was the 11th Earl of Scarbrough. That friend is a certain kind of creature that a famous PGA golfer was nicknamed after due to his portly build and ample mustache. In 1982, what score did that golfer record in the 1st round of the only Major he would ever win? (2)

**Q4.** Oh no! That's a bit of bad luck. Fun fact: The man in blue who's telling you where you need to go to (potentially) spend your next three turns has a last name. That surname is the same as the first name of a female character from a popular 80s sitcom that's best remembered for providing the big U.S. break to the actor whose first TV acting role was on a CBC sitcom called 'Leo and Me'. The actress who played this female character is the real life older sibling of a fairly well-known and well-regarded actor/director/producer. What is the larger of the two area codes used in the city in which HIS famous father-in-law was born? (3)

**Q5.** Good thing we supplied your team with a 'Get Out of Jail' free card. No missed turns or having to roll doubles for you! (If you're now on a property containing the name of a sea, you must not have played Monopoly before. Re-read the instructions and try again.) Chances are, the first thing you think of when you think of the state this property was named after is either bourbon or a sporting event. The first edition of that sporting event was run in 1875. If you look at the list of winners of that race (I'll save you some time...check the 1950's), you'll come across a name that looks pretty much like the name of a drummer for an infamous rock group (save for a missing letter 'm'). That drummer's third wife is a Canadian-born, former Playboy centerfold who is probably best-known for her role as a lifeguard on a 90s TV show. That show was set in the home state of a one hit wonder group with a moniker that looks like it was taken from band member with the same first name as the drummer we just mentioned...but it's not. Their biggest (okay, ONLY) hit was in 1981 about a girl named Jenny. Her phone number is in the song's title. What is the prefix (i.e. first three digits) of that phone number? (3)

**Q6.** The largest city in the state mentioned in the name of this property is home to an airport that was the busiest in the world from 1963 until 1998. The three letter IATA location identifier of that airport shows up in the surname of a Canadian prime minister. His portrait has appeared on what denomination of Canadian currency, although it's slated to be replaced during the next redesign? (3)

**Q7.** A current Canadian band took their name from the deepest point in the ocean referenced by this property. In July of 2014, they released a single featuring Anami Vice that had a number in the title. The lyrics of that song mention a music act that is one of the few in history to have played the halftime show at both the Grey Cup and the Super Bowl. In the Super Bowl contest they appeared at, how many passing yards did the game's MVP record? (3)

**Q8.** This property's name shows up with a preposition and an article to form the name of a famous song that was recorded May 21, 1964, even though the group's regular lead singer had died the night before. The group's other singer assumed lead vocals on the track and the rest was history. Seven other artists have recorded versions of the song that charted in the U.S. or overseas. In the song's lyrics, there's a line that reads "...you hear the happy sound of the \_\_\_\_" from a park, where the blank is filled in by a word that was used by a band representing Latvia at the Eurovision Song contest in what year? (4)

**Q9.** The state contained in the name of this square was the setting for a classic 80s sitcom set in a small town inn. The owner of the inn was played by a famous comedian who won Grammys in 1961 for Album of the Year AND Best New Artist, the only time that's been done by a comedian. He originally wanted to call the album "The Best New Comedian since \*blank\*" where the blank would have been filled with the name of a notorious (and feared) fifth century tribal leader. But, I digress. How many locations of the restaurant franchise that used to have a mascot named Speedee are there in the capital of the state found in the name of this property? (1)

**Q10.** The first two words of the three used to name the property you just landed on form the name of the first steamboat to navigate the upper part of a river in northern Alberta in the early 1900s. The word that precedes 'River' in this river's name served as the one-word title of the eighth and final album release of a well-known British pop duo that had a lot of chart success in the 1980s. The female member of that duo is currently how many years old? (2)

**Q11.** The largest city in this state is known by many nicknames but one of those is particularly fruity. A variety of that fruit sounds like it was named for a family member but it was actually named after a British-Australian orchardist who had the given name Maria Ann. In 2013, the US Postal Service released a stamp to honor that particular type of the fruit, one of four kinds in total. What was the value (in cents) of that stamp? (2)

**Q12.** The proper male first name in the title of this property is the same as the given name of a now 72-year-old rocker whose stage name is also a well-known comfort food. In addition to his music career, he's appeared in over 50 movies and TV shows, including the Rocky Horror Picture Show and Fight Club. In the latter, he played a character whose last name is the same as the real last name of a woman who was one of the first women scientists employed at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory as a \*checks notes on Wikipedia\* human computer. What year did that female scientist marry her husband Harry? (4)

**Q13.** That's it. You're back where you started! There's no clue here. Just replace the symbols in the coordinate with the numbers in the same placing in the answers you've uncovered, plug them into the appropriate slots of this coordinate and transfer it to Google Maps to find out your next destination. (Pro tip. Don't forget your parka!)
