As a Swedish educated and trained clinical dermatologist I have a broad experience in diagnosing and treating a variety of skin conditions on adults and children such as: Allergic contact dermatitis, complex skin disorders, skin infections, rosacea, eczema, psoriasis, auto-immune skin conditions, pre-cancerous skin lesions, skin cancer (both melanoma and non-melanoma), acne, vitiligo, nail disorders, hair and scalp disorders, pigmentation disorders, urticarias, leg ulcers and sexual transmitted diseases (STD). Treatments I perform (local, oral and biological), including but not limited to; Customized skincare programs, skin biopsy, skin cancer screening: diagnosis and treatment, skin cancer surgery, precancerous treatments, skinsurgery: removal of moles and other skin growths, hair disorders: diagnosis and treatment, nails: diagnosis and treatment of infections, deformity and discoloration, photodynamic therapy (PDT), PUVA, BUCKY, Wood's light, Patch testing for allergic contact dermatitis, light treatments (UVA/UVB), cryotherapy, electrocautery, diathermy, full-body skin checks and molemapping etc.
