Beginning Quilting: The Easy Strip Runner*

Mon. April 7th 9:30am-4:00pm Fee: \$52 Instructor: Kris Califano

Learn the basics of quilting using Pat's Precut Table Runner Kit. Great for a first project and learning to quilt or brush up on your skills. You will learn a perfect ¼" seam allowance, layering techniques and machine quilt your runner using a walking foot and a basic quilting design. You should complete the runner in class!

Basic sewing skills needed.



Mon. April 28th 9:30am-4:00pm Fee: \$52 Instructor: Kris Califano Learn and perfect your machine quilting skills. You must be comfortable with your machine and its basic capabilities and be able to drop the feed dogs on your machine. We will quickly go through all the steps leading up to quilting, including marking, layering, and basting your samples in a variety of ways. We will then begin with straight stitching using the Walking Foot/Dual Feed Foot and proceed to Free Motion Quilting, using the Darning Foot or Freehand Quilting Foot. You MUST bring all these supplies to truly benefit from this class. Please bring your best sewing machine, I'm assuming this is one of the reasons you purchased it and this is a good chance to learn its capabilities.



Get Your Walking Foot Out of the Ditch**

Now that you have mastered 9-Patches and piecing straight lines, we will move on to triangles and make this 3-block Pinwheel Table Runner. You will perfect your ¼" seam allowance as triangles require this accuracy. You'll learn rotary cutting, the perfect ¼" seam for machine piecing triangles, calculating and adding borders, basting the layers together, machine quilting, and finally binding the quilt while creating this table runner. You should be able to finish piecing the top but might not finish quilting the layers or binding the quilt in class
