
### Embroidery Basics 3\*

screen.



The wall hanging finishes at 38inch square, and the lap quilt finishes to 48inch square. We will cut and learn to piece but will not finish the top in class. Class fee includes pattern and interfacing.

We will then begin with straight stitching using the Walking Foot/Dual Feed Foot and proceed to Free Motion Quilting, using the Darning Foot or Freehand Quilting Foot.

with the max. hoop size of 4x4.)


