

This bag has a back slip pocket, interior welt zipper pocket, interior divided zipper pocket, and exterior side slip pockets to hold your phone or keys. During this class you will learn to create accordion gussets for an

expandable zipper pocket, make a card slot lining, create five different pocket views, and use varying hardware for different looks. You will learn a bias tape interior finish, which also aids in the bag structure.



## Sandhill Sling\*\*

Students will need a working, portable sewing machine to bring to class. There will be homework in between the 2 class sessions.



## Applique Table Runner\*\*
