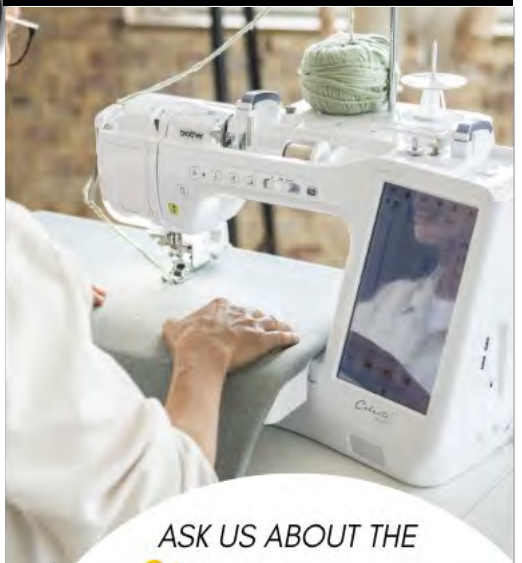

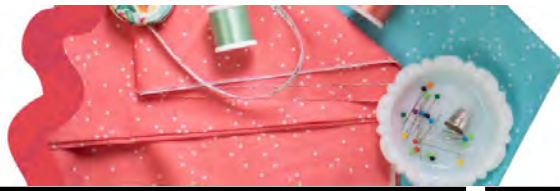

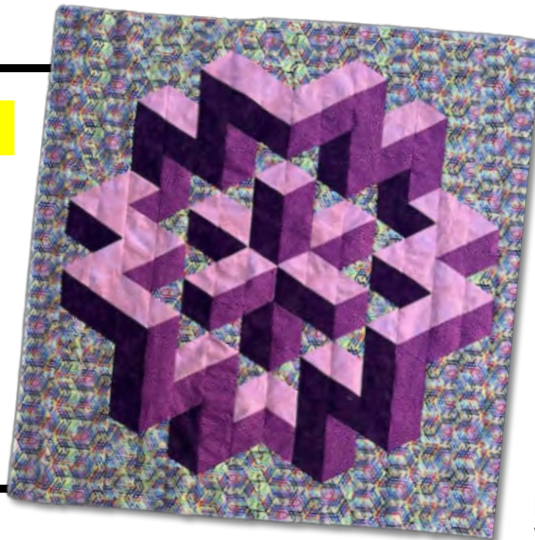
3D Asterisk Quilt Top**

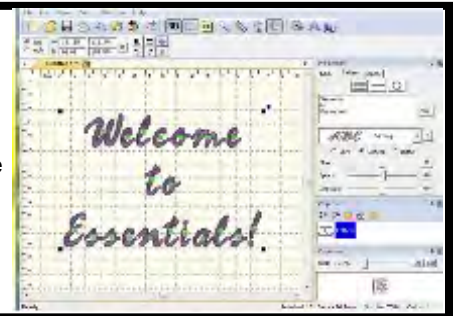

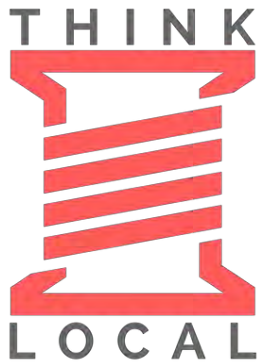
