There are several different types of pockets (slip pockets, zipper pockets) that can be made for this tote bag. If you want to add rivets, we can do that as well. You can decide whatever you want as far as the pockets and the placement of the straps. I will assist you with whatever you choose. This is a great bag for learning multiple techniques.

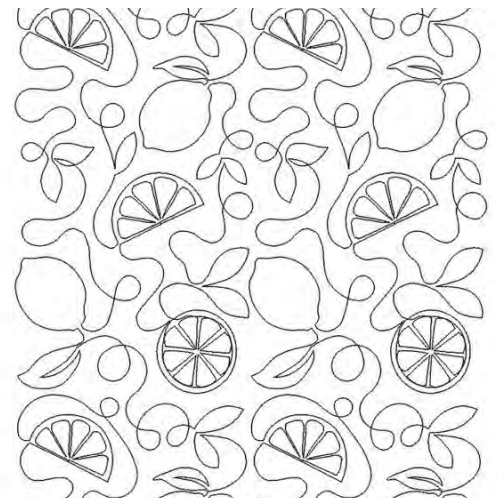

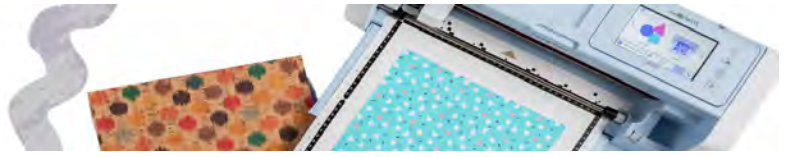
Sublimation Sequin Pillow Project* **NEW**

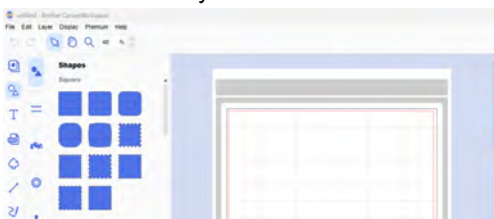
