There are no patient age restrictions. CooperVision Specialty EyeCare leaves it to the discretion of the university clinic to determine who is a financially eligible candidate.

The Make a Difference Program solely provides a pair of warranted lenses at no cost. Coverage or reimbursement for additional fees such as clinic and examination fees are excluded from the program.
