The Florida Society of Association Executives (FSAE) presented its most prestigious leadership awards at its recent Annual Conference held at the Hilton Orlando Bonnet Creek. The *Association of the Year* award honors organizations that demonstrates outstanding efforts, excellence and innovation.

Since its inception in 1977, the **Florida Association of School Administrators'** mission is to support school administrators in providing high-quality education to the 2.9 million students of Florida by protecting public education and fostering leadership development for principals and assistant principals as well as district-level administrators and superintendents.
