(VERIFY IF PERSON IS 18 YEARS OLD OR OLDER. IF NO ONE AVAILABLE, TERMINATE.)

- 1. Pretend for a minute that the State of New Mexico was a car. Would you say it works fine as it is, it needs a minor tune up, or would you say it needs a major overhaul?**

5% Works fine as it is  
44% Needs a minor tune up  
47% Needs major overhaul  
4% Don't know/No Answer *(DO NOT READ)*

- 2. Next I want to ask you a few questions having to do with issues affecting people who are dying of a terminal disease or illness. In general, would you *strongly favor*, *somewhat favor*, *somewhat oppose* or *strongly oppose* allowing a mentally competent adult, who is dying of a terminal disease with no hope of recovery, the choice to request and receive medication from his/her physician, which could bring about their own death, if there were appropriate safeguards in place to protect patients against abuse?**

37% Strongly favor  
28% Somewhat favor  
10% Somewhat oppose  
19% Strongly oppose  
6% Not sure *(DO NOT READ)*  
1% Refused *(DO NOT READ)*

- 3. Next, people express different views about issues having to do with people who are dying of a terminal disease. Which of the following statements comes closer to your point of view. *(READ AND ROTATE RESPONSES 1 AND 2)***

54% If I am terminally ill with no hope of recovery, the decision about when I end my suffering is my own to make.

**OR**

39% Human life is sacred. Only God should decide when my life ends.  
4% Neither *(DO NOT READ)*  
2% Don't know/No answer *(DO NOT READ)*

- 4. Please tell me whether you *strongly agree*, *somewhat agree*, *somewhat disagree* or *strongly disagree* with the following statement: In the event I am diagnosed with a terminal illness, I want to be able to control my suffering and preserve my dignity and be in control of my own pain management as I see fit, including being able to receive physician assistance to end my own life.**

44% Strongly agree

17% Strongly disagree

**15. Do you consider yourself to be a born-again Christian, or do you describe your faith in some other way? (Among Protestant/Christians/Catholics n=469)**

- 34% Born again
- 59% Other way
