Supplies

- Clothespin
- · Googly eye
- Yarn
- Beads
- Pipecleaner

Directions

- 1. Using markers, color the clothespin.
- 2. Wrap yarn around 3 of your fingers. Once you have a nice sized bundle, slide it off your fingers and tie a separate piece of yarn around the center. Tie tightly into a double knot.
- 3. Trim the looped ends of the yarn and glue the middle of this bundle to the top of the clothespin. This will be your monster's hair.
- 4. Put a pipe cleaner through the center of the clothespin. Thread a bead onto each end of pipe cleaner to make the hands and twist the pipe cleaner ends around themselves so that the beads stay in place.
- 5. Glue googly eye on the top of the clothes pin.
