WHERE YOU CAN FIND GOD'S PROMISES

1. Stay connected to scripture daily

Ps Phil Strong shares ways to access the scriptures daily using tools like the Bible App on your phone to read or to listen to the scriptures while you go about your everyday tasks.

- Take some time to find the key verses you can use to stay anchored. Consider the areas in your life that you need a promise for.

2. Spend time in prayer to find His promises.

Prophetic ministry or prayer time is the **Rhema** word of God, it is used to edify, uplift and encourage, and it is always in agreement with scripture.

- What was the last thing God said to you?

This is a time when you were absolutely certain in your spirit, and were convicted in your mind that this was a word from God. It could also be a time where you have received a word of prophecy from a friend or heard something in a sermon and felt the presence of God convicting you.

Now that you've found your promises **capture** and **agree** with them so you can take them into 2022.
