From the Heart

Hey Salem Family!

About a month ago I had the opportunity to preach to you all and spoke on finding a rhythm of rest in our lives. This past week I was reading in Mark 1:21–34 which

records what I like to call Jesus's busiest day and it reminds me of where we find our rest. He starts his day teaching in the synagogue, then he casts out a demon. Talk about an exciting church service! After synagogue he goes to Peter's house, maybe for a nice post church lunch and ends up healing Peters mother-in-law. By now his fame is starting to spread and people want some of that miracle action. Verse 33 says "the whole city was gathered together at the door." He had no time for a Sunday nap that day.

I imagine that if it was any of us in his situation, we would do one of two things. Some of us might grumble the whole time, because we just wanted our Sunday afternoon to go the way we wanted it to. Others might ride the high of a super fruitful day of ministry and look to keep the train rolling while we have the crowds. Yet Jesus does neither. What he does might surprise some of us. "And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed." (v. 35) This was a common habit for Jesus. He often withdrew to deserted places and prayed. He knew that powerful ministry was fueled by purposeful time with the Father and he knew that true rest is found in His presence.

What "crowd" do you need to step away from in order to spend time with God this week? Take time this week to spend timeß just talking with God. You'll walk away from that more rested.


