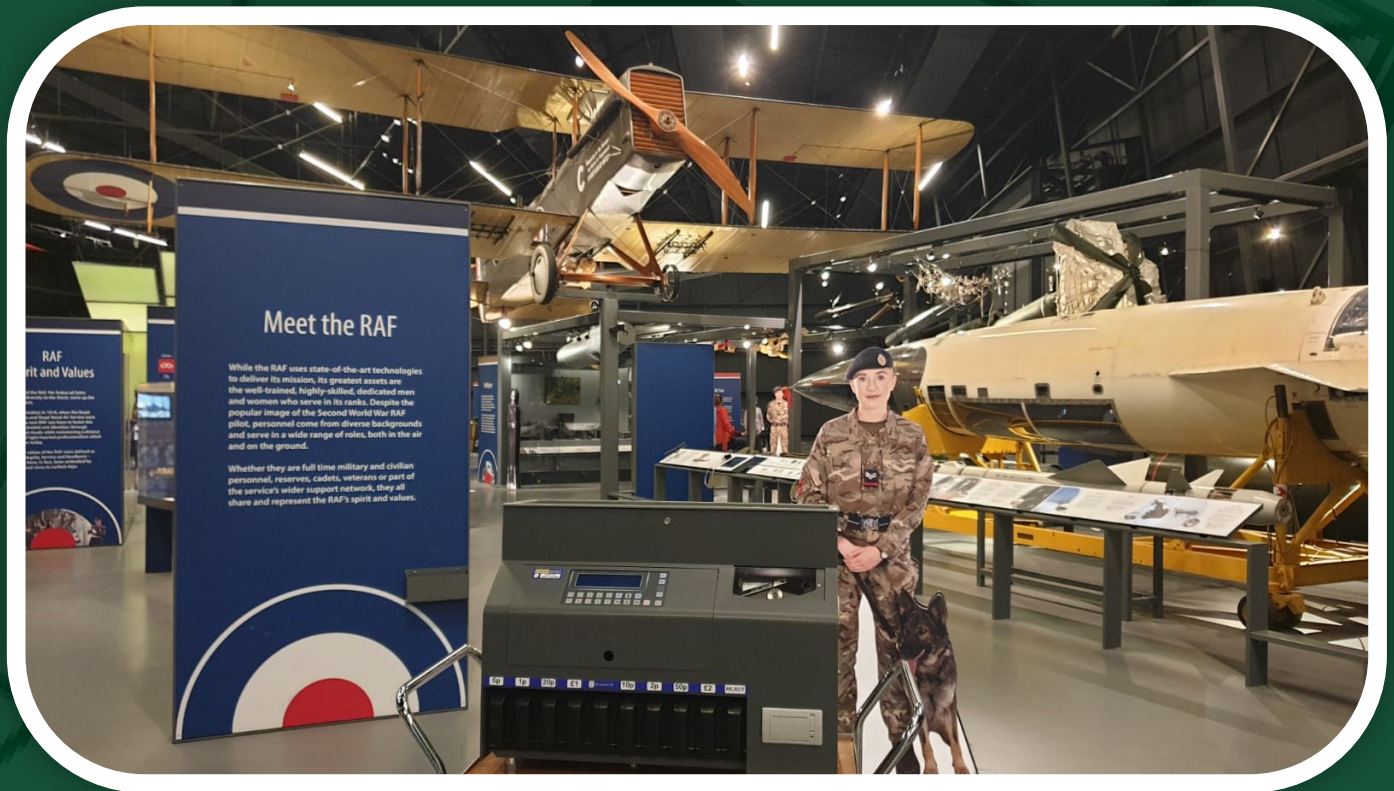

About

Opening in 1972, The Royal Air Force Museum is a National Museum. The collection comprises around 1.3 million objects each telling its own story. Their ambition, and responsibility, is to continue to share these stories, for past, present, and future and to engage, inspire and encourage learning, for current and future generations.



The Challenge

The RAF Museum welcomes one million visitors annually, with free entry to both amazing sites, in London and the Midlands. Any donations given by the public, ensure that the RAF story endures, enriches and inspires future generations through innovative interpretive, curatorial, conservation, research and learning programmes.

Without generous gifts, the sheer breadth of the 1.3 million objects that they hold in trust for the nation could not be restored and maintained.

The Solution

With the high quantity of visitors, the RAF is highly likely to receive coin donations which are situated around their site.

When required, precision coin counters and coin sorters are ideal for speeding up the process of counting the value of the coins, as well as the potential counting errors.

The TG910S+, from TG Systems, is a coin counting and sorting machine that can sort up to 9 denominations and will reject foreign coins, counterfeit coins and tokens etc.

It has already been developed and customised for 40 currencies. It is ideal for counting and sorting large volume coins fast and accurately.

With the standard pre-sorting tray, the hopper can hold up to 3600 coins and will sort out foreign items such as clips and screws.
