



Pathways to Success Oregon Tradeswomen	Adults ages 18+ with a focus on low-income, BIPOC, veteran, and formerly incarcerated in Portland Metro	Focusing on apprenticeship, this 192- hour apprenticeship and employment readiness training program prepares adult job-seekers for a career in the skilled construction trades.	APPLY NOW  Now enrolling for winter 2023
Construction Pre- Apprenticeship POIC	18-24 year olds with a GED or high school diploma in Portland	A 12-week program preparing adults for careers in construction and the trades. Trainees are paid during this hands-on learning experience.	SIGN UP Students accepted on a rolling basis
<b>Bridge</b> Portland YouthBuilders	18-26 year olds with a GED or high school diploma in Portland Metro	Student earn a stipend in this 9-week program while receiving training and support to enter an apprenticeship program and start a career in construction.
