Autumn Wreath is a beautiful block made with two fundamental Studio 180 Design tools: the Tucker Trimmer and the Wing Clipper. Go back to basics with this fun and seasonal new block.

If you are making the 7" or 14" block, you will need to use the Eighth Inch Tucker Trimmer® and Wing Clipper® Tools.

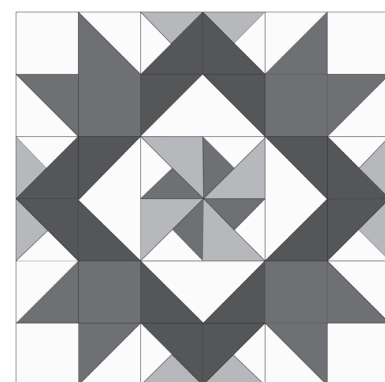
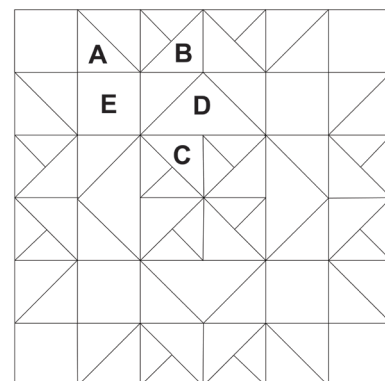

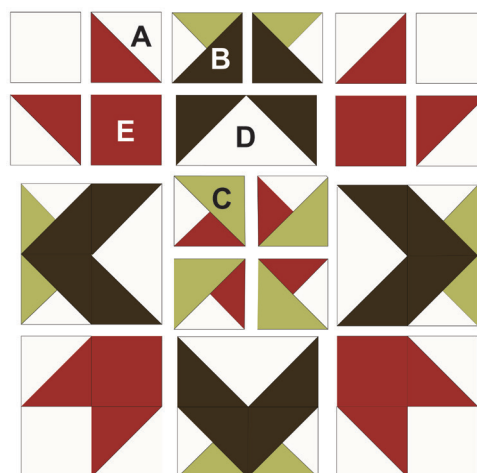

A: Half Square Triangles 8 Units	1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size	2" Finished 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Cut size	2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size
B: Combination Units 8 Units	1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size	2" Finished 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Cut size	2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size
C: Non-Mirrored Combination 4 Units	1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size	2" Finished 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Cut size	2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size
D: Flying Geese 4 Units	1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Finished 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Cut size	2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Finished 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Cut size
E: Squares 8 Pieces	1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size	2" Finished 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Cut size	2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Finished 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Cut size



Block Assembly

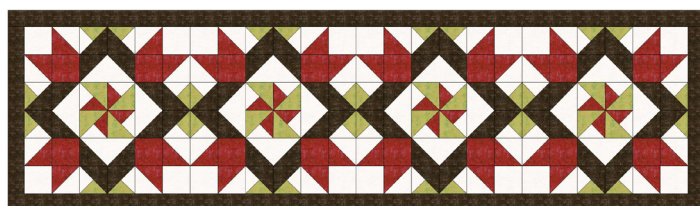
1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams open.

Make (1) Block.

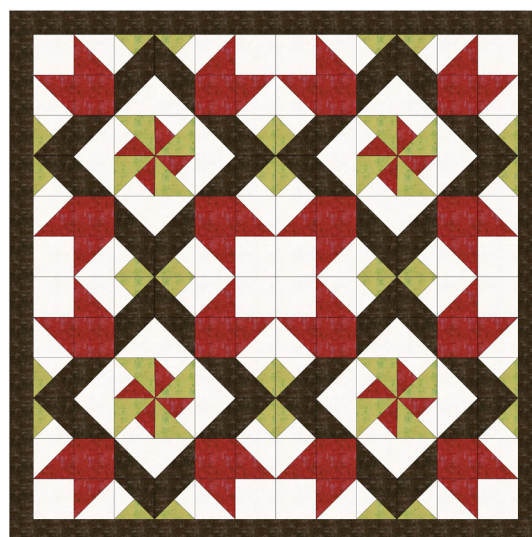

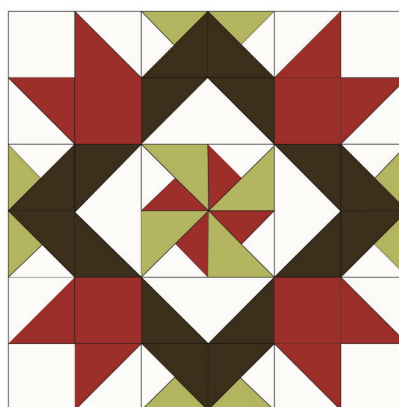
