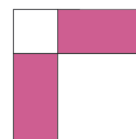

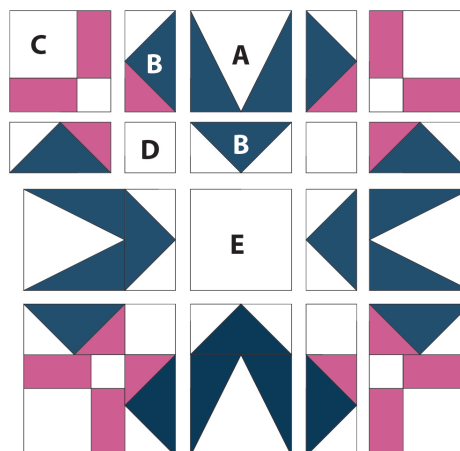
Unit Name and # of Units	8"	12"	16"
A: V Block 4 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
B: Flying Geese 12 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" Cut size	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" Cut size
C: Offset Four Patch 4 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
D: Small Squares 4 Units	1" Finished 1 ½" Cut size	1 ½" Finished 2" Cut size	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size
E: Large Squares 1 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size



Block Assembly

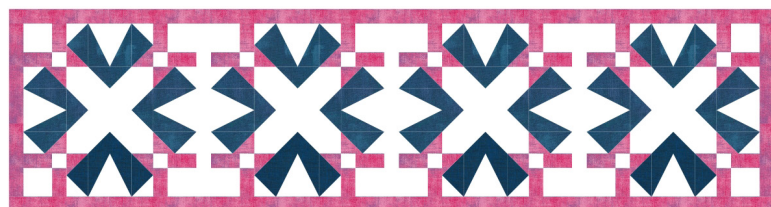
1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams open.

Make (1) Block.

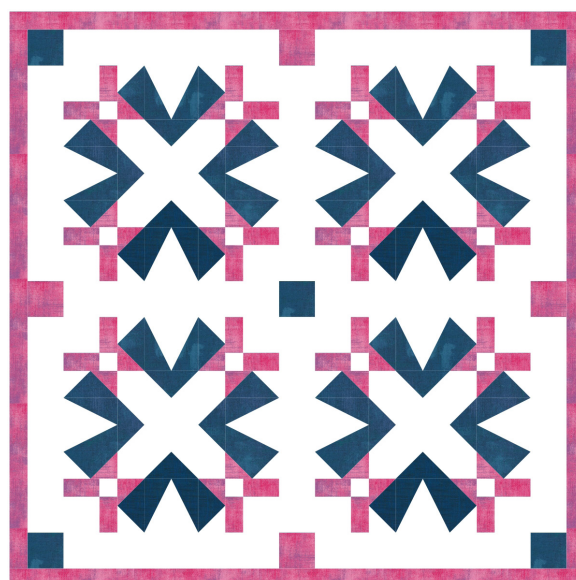
