




A: Flying Geese 12 Units	1 1/2" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 1/2" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Cut size	2 1/2" x 5" Finished 3" x 5 1/2" Cut size
B: Popped Squares 4 Units	3" Finished 3 1/2" Cut size	4" Finished 4 1/2" Cut size	5" Finished 5 1/2" Cut size
Corner Pop® I - Finish / Cut Away size on the Corner Pop® I tool / Corner Trim Down Line

Block Assembly


1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams open.

Make (1) Block.




