Cutting Instructions: Per Block

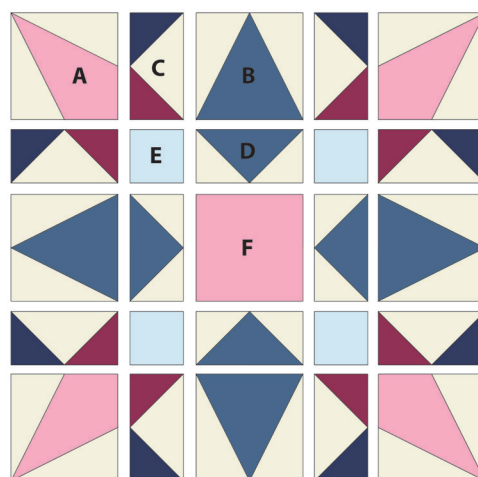
Unit Name and # of Units	8"	12"	16"
A: Corner Beam 4 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
B: V Block 4 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
C: Partical Color Flying Geese 8 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" Cut size	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" Cut size
D: Partical Color Flying Geese 4 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" Cut size	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" Cut size
E: Squares 4 Units	1 ½"	2"	2 ½"
F: Squares 1 Unit	2 ½"	3 ½"	4 ½"



Block Assembly

1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams as desired.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams as desired.

Make (1) Block.

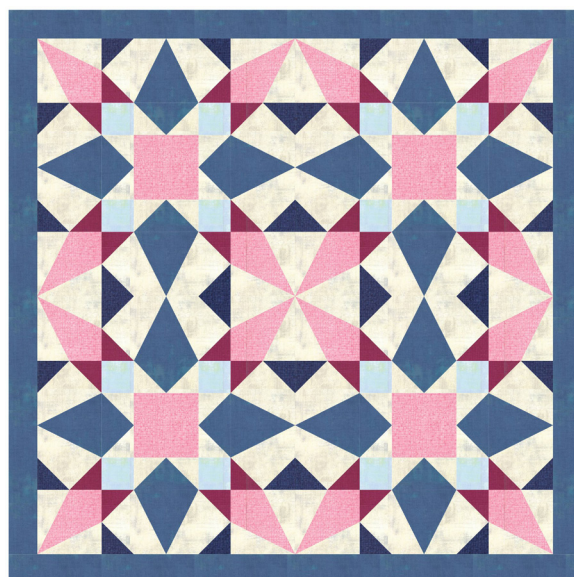
