




Cutting Instructions: Per Block


Unit Name and # of Units	9"	12"	18"
A: Nine Patch 4 units	3" Finished 3 1/2" Cut size	4" Finished 4 1/2" Cut size	6" Finished 6 1/2" Cut size
B: Flying Geese 8 units	1 1/2" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 1/2" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Cut size	3" x 6" Finished 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Cut size
C: Square 1 unit	3" Finished 3 1/2" Cut size	4" Finished 4 1/2" Cut size	6" Finished 6 1/2" Cut size



Block Assembly

1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams as desired.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams as desired.

Make (1) Block.


