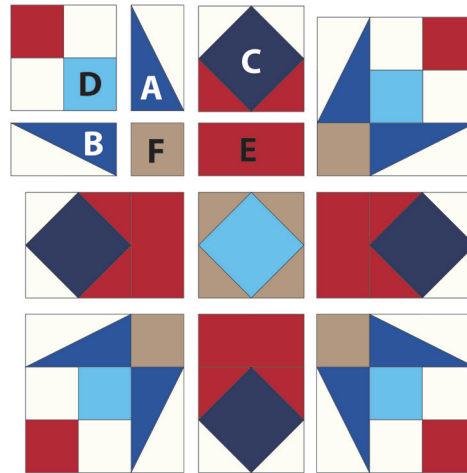
Unit Name and # of Units	8"	12"	16"
<b>A: Split Rects Type 1</b> 4 units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" Cut size	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" Cut size
<b>B: Split Rects Type 2</b> 4 units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" Cut size	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" Cut size	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" Cut size
<b>C: Square Squared</b> 5 unit	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
<b>D: Four Patch</b> 4 unit	2" Finished 2 ½" Cut size	3" Finished 3 ½" Cut size	4" Finished 4 ½" Cut size
<b>E: Rectangles</b> 4 unit	1 ½" x 2 ½" Cut size	2" x 3 ½" Cut size	2 ½" x 4 ½" Cut size
<b>F: Squares</b> 4 unit	2 ½" Cut size	3 ½" Cut size	4 ½" Cut size



## Block Assembly

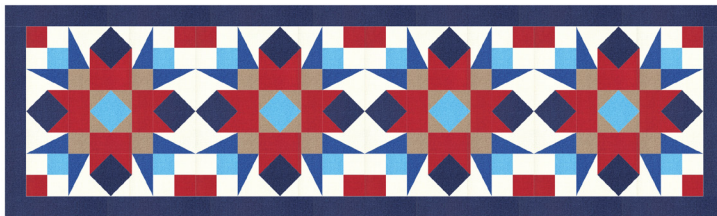
1. Layout the block according to the diagram.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams as desired.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams as desired.

**Make (1) Block.**

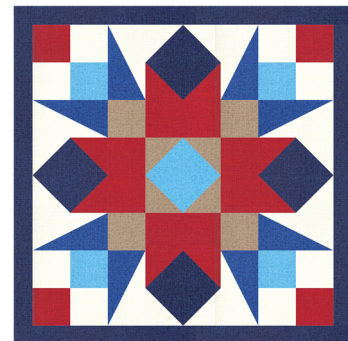

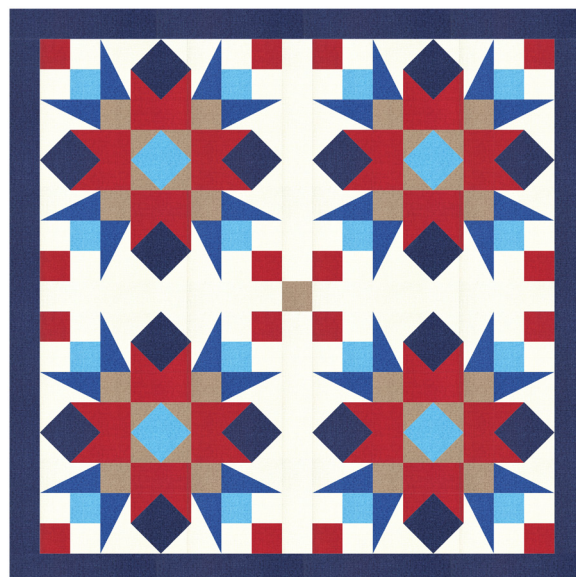
