

New Discussion Experience

We're pleased to share that after an eight-month "preview," the New Discussion Create/Edit Experience is now the only experience in D2L.

This update is a step towards streamlining the teaching experience by aligning the discussion creation process with Quizzes and Assignments. In addition to the

new, two-paned layout, there is also a new forum selection prompt when creating a topic for discussions. This enhancement aims to provide you with



more control and flexibility in organizing and managing your course discussion forums and topics.

IntelliWriter in D2L

IntelliWriter is a virtual writing coach designed to help students improve their writing in real-time across multiple disciplines and languages. Powered by artificial intelligence, IntelliWriter provides immediate feedback and adaptive revision directives. This application replaces Grammarly and is available now to all Lone Star College faculty, students, and staff.

Features of IntelliWriter include:

- Live collaboration
- A Writer's Guide, which is a library of cross-curricular writing instructional documents

SoftChalk Migration

Lone Star College has successfully transitioned SoftChalk Cloud to a new enterprise environment, incorporating Single Sign-On (SSO)



and providing us with unlimited licenses. The migration, which completed on December 19th, brings both convenience and changes for faculty members.

The introduction of SSO means faculty now only need to log in to SoftChalk Cloud once through D2L, after which SoftChalk will remember your login from then on. However, it's crucial to note that **all existing links** to SoftChalk lessons in your D2L courses **must be updated**, as the old links no longer work.

SoftChalk Cloud hyperlinks can be updated by editing the hyperlink to use the new URL for SoftChalk Cloud. To update LTI (integration) links, faculty must delete the old LTI link, as well as any associated Grade Items, and add a new LTI link which points to the new environment.

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Enhancing Face-to-Face Teaching with D2L

Centralized Resource Hub:

D2L serves as a centralized hub for course materials, enabling you to upload lecture notes, presentations, videos, links and additional resources in one location. This facilitates easy access for students both during and after face-to-face sessions, promoting a continuous learning experience.

Discussions:

The discussion forums feature on D2L allows you to extend classroom discussions beyond physical meeting times. You can post reflective questions, share additional materials, or encourage peer-to-peer interaction. This provides an opportunity for shy or reserved students to contribute to discussions in a more comfortable setting.

Assessments:

You can use the assessment tools on D2L to create quizzes, assignments, and surveys. This functionality supports ongoing assessment and allows you to provide prompt feedback, a more responsive teaching approach.

Announcements and Notifications:

Keeping students informed is crucial for engagement. D2L's announcement and notification features allow you to communicate important updates, reminders, or changes to the course schedule instantly. This ensures that students stay well-informed and engaged in the course.

Third-party Integrations:

This feature enables you to integrate the online resources associated with your text for students, providing a seamless transition to an online learning environment when appropriate.




- Cite.ai, an Al-powered plagiarism checker
