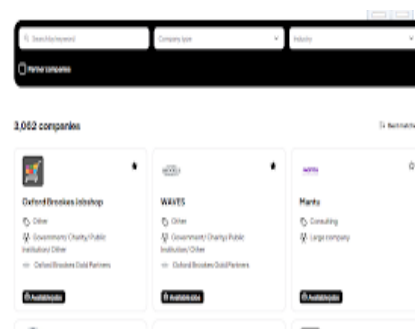

Pro Bono legal advice with Citizens Advice Bureau Oxfordshire



Law students at Oxford Brookes University have partnered with Citizens Advice Oxfordshire to launch a new clinic offering free support to people across the county. The clinic will provide supervised, real-world experience for law students working directly with clients, while helping to meet growing demand for free, accessible legal advice in the local community.

The clinic will run every other Wednesday and will be staffed by qualified solicitors and legal advisers who are volunteering their time to advise clients on a wide range of issues, including, immigration, family, and employment matters. Law students will work alongside the solicitors, supporting clients by accompanying them to appointments, assisting with form filling, and signposting them to other relevant services and agencies.
