MRI appeal on the Home Run



Love Musgrove, the Official Charity of Musgrove Park Hospital, is on the home run to raising £1 million for a third MRI scanner.

Within 8 months £900,000 has been donated and they are working hard to raise the final £100,000. Most people will require an MRI Scanner at some point their life or know someone who will.

MAN vs FAT comes to Taunton

MAN vs FAT Football is coming to Taunton and will launch with a registration session on Sunday 5th August.

MAN v FAT Football has been running successfully in Somerset since 2016 with local men losing 3.5 tonnes in weight taking part in what is essentially a weight loss programme for overweight and obese men based around a 6 a-side football league where every player has an opportunity to influence the overall score regardless of their footballing ability.

The league coach, Roger Smith has told Tone News: "Every time a player stands on the scales and loses weight he scores half a goal for his team, with an extra goal scored when he loses weight for 3 weeks and 3 goals scored when he loses 5% and 10% of his starting body weight respectively. All the guys really support and encourage each other to do well for themselves and for the team and it's great to see so many men take a genuine interest in the health and well-being of those around them. The camaraderie within our programme is a major part of why this programme works for men in a way that other programmes may not."

The Taunton league will take place at 1610 Castle Sports Centre on Sunday mornings between 10am and 12pm so is ideal for all those old Sunday league players who may want to rekindle their playing days but feel too old or too unfit but MAN v FAT Football is designed to help any man with a BMI over 27.5 that is looking to lose weight and live a lighter, fitter and healthier life.


the very best quality care and support is given."



Taunton Businesses to benefit from £2.5m Skills Training Pot

Small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) in Taunton are being urged to take advantage of a £2.5m skills training pot for their workforce, as a result of a contract extension.

The training is available as part of a programme named Heart of the South West Apprenticeship Service which Serco's Employment, Skills & Enterprise business manages across Devon and Somerset - working in partnership with the Heart of the South West Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP).




Are you looking for support with childcare costs?

Getting help with your childcare costs is easier than you might think. The Childcare Choices website brings together all the government childcare offers in one place, including two new schemes for working parents: Tax-free childcare and up to 30 hours a week funded childcare for 3 and 4 year olds. www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

Families in Somerset are already benefitting from these offers. If you are a working parent and you have a child that is three years old by 31 August you can apply **now** for up to 30 hours a week funded childcare to use from **September 2018.** If you are successful you will receive an eligibility code to take to your early years provider.

If you already have a 30 hours childcare place you must reconfirm you are still eligible every three months. It is easy to do just check the secure messages in your childcare service account. Go to gov.uk/childcareaccount


